**MATERIALS:** CHADWICK'S RED HEART WOOL FLOSS (2 Ply), 3 balls (1 oz. balls) each of Cherry Red, Blue Jewel and Black for Sizes 12 and 14; 4 balls of each color for Size 16 . . . Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 2 (2 $\frac{3}{4}$  mm. size) . . . Bone Crochet Hook No. 1 . . . 1 small black button . . . Narrow leather belt . . . Shoulder pads.

**GAUGE:** 7 $\frac{1}{2}$  sts make 1 inch; 10 rows make 1 inch.

**LEFT POCKET . . .** Starting at lower edge with Cherry, cast on 38 sts. Work straight in stockinette st (k 1 row, p 1 row) for 2 $\frac{1}{4}$  inches, ending with a purl row. Bind off 8 sts at beginning of next row, then dec 1 st at decreased edge every other row until 12 sts remain. Bind off. Make a rnd of sc all around edges, making 3 sc in each corner.

**RIGHT POCKET . . .** Work as for Left Pocket, using Blue and reversing all shaping.

Block all pieces to measurements. Sew underarm and shoulder seams. Make a row of sc around all edges, using

matching color yarn. Sew pockets in place, having lower edges of pockets in line with lower edge of sweater. Sew in shoulder pads. Make a ch-6 buttonloop at top of right center back opening. Sew button opposite buttonloop. Make a ch-6 loop on both sides of waistline, using matching color yarn. Draw belt through loops.

**MATERIALS:** CHADWICK'S RED HEART WOOL FLOSS (2 Ply), 3 balls (1 oz. balls) each of Scarlet, Blue Jewel and White for Sizes 12 and 14; 4 balls for Size 16 . . . Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 2 (2 $\frac{3}{4}$  mm. size) . . . Bone Crochet Hook No. 1 . . . 2 small buttons . . . Shoulder pads.

**GAUGE:** 7 $\frac{1}{2}$  sts make 1 inch; 10 rows make 1 inch.

Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 2 (2 3/4 mm. size) . . . Shoulder pads . . . 2 yards of grosgrain ribbon, 1 1/2 inches wide . . . 3 1/2 yards of grosgrain ribbon, 1/2 inch wide . . . Brown buckle.

Block pieces to measurements. Sew side, shoulder and sleeve seams, matching pattern. Sew sleeves in. Baste a piece of narrow ribbon inside waistline, easing in to fit. Sew in place. Turn under  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch on all edges. Face front with wide ribbon from lower edge to shoulder seams. Face back of neck, lower edge and wrists with narrow ribbon. Press belt pieces flat with seam at center and sew ends. Try on jacket. Sew belt pieces to fronts at waistline. Fasten with a buckle, or with snap fasteners and a button. Tack shoulder pads in place.

Knitting Pins, 1 pair No. 2 (2 3/4 mm. size) . . . Bone Crochet Hook No. 1 . . . Black jet beads . . . Shoulder pads . . . 1/2 yard of elastic.

**18th row:** Same as 14th row. **19th row:** Purl 9 sts 13 sts 17 sts \* k 1, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., k 1, p 19. Repeat from \* across, ending with purl 9 sts 13 sts 17 sts

**20th row:** Same as 12th row. **21st row:** Purl 9 sts 13 sts 17 sts \* sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., p 19. Repeat from \* across, ending with purl 9 sts 13 sts 17 sts

**22nd row:** K across. **23rd to 32nd rows incl:** Work in stockinette st. **33rd row:** Purl 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts

\* O, k 1, O, p 19. Repeat from \* across, ending with purl 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts

**34th row:** Knit 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts \* p 3, k 19. Repeat from \* across, ending with knit 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts

**35th row:** Purl 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts \* O, k 3, O, p 19. Repeat from \* across, ending with purl 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts

**36th row:** Knit 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts \* p 5, k 19. Repeat from \* across, ending with knit 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts

**37th row:** Purl 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts \* O, k 5, O, p 19. Repeat from \* across, ending with purl 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts

**38th row:** Knit 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts \* p 7, k 19. Repeat from \* across, ending with knit 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts

**39th row:** Purl 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts \* k 2, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., k 2, p 19. Repeat from \* across, ending with purl 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts

**40th row:** Same as 36th row. **41st row:** Purl 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts \* k 1, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., k 1, p 19. Repeat from \* across, ending with purl 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts

**42nd row:** Same as 34th row. **43rd row:** Purl 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts \* sl 1, k 2 tog, p 19. Repeat from \* across, ending with purl 19 sts 3 sts 7 sts

**44th row:** Knit across. The last 44 rows constitute the pattern. Work straight in pattern until piece measures in all 4 1/2" 5" 5"

**Keeping continuity of pattern throughout all shaping,** inc 1 st at both ends of the next row and every 4th row thereafter until there are on needle 129 sts 137 sts 145 sts

Work straight until piece measures in all 11" 11 1/2" 12"

**To Shape Armholes:** Bind off at the beginning of the next 2 rows 7 sts 8 sts 9 sts Dec 1 st at both ends of every other row until there remain 103 sts 107 sts 111 sts

Work straight until piece measures from 1st row of armhole shaping 6 1/2" 7" 7 1/2"

**To Shape Shoulders:** Bind off 6 sts 6 sts 7 sts at the beginning of the next 8 rows 4 rows 8 rows

**In Size 14 only,** bind off 7 sts at the beginning of the next 4 rows. Bind off the remaining sts for back of neck.

Ch 9, sc on wrong side of sleeve 1/2 inch above edge and 1/4 inch to right of place where yarn was attached. \* Ch 9, sc on edge of sleeve 1/4 inch to right of last sc, ch 9, sc on wrong side of sleeve 1/2 inch above edge and 1/4 inch to right of last sc. Repeat from \* around. Break off. Cut elastic to fit top arm, draw through casing and sew ends together. Sew in shoulder pads.

**GAUGE:** 8 sts make 1 inch; 12 rows make 1 inch.

**RIGHT POINT . . .** Starting at lower edge of Right Point, cast on 3 sts. **1st row:** Inc 1 st in first st, p 1, k 1. **2nd row:** Inc 1 st in first st—place a marker for front edge—k 1, p 1, inc 1 st in last st—place a marker for side edge. **3rd row:** Inc 1 st in first st, k 2, p 1, k 2. **4th row:** K across, increasing 1 st in the 1st and last sts (right side of work). **5th row:** Inc 1 st in first st, k 1, (p 1, k 2) twice; p 1. **6th row:** Inc 1 st in first st, (p 2, k 1) twice; p 2, inc 1 st in last st. **7th row:** Inc 1 st in first st, (p 1, k 2) 3 times; p 1, k 1. **8th row:** Same as 4th row. **9th row:** Inc 1 st in first st, (k 2, p 1) 4 times; k 2. **10th row:** Inc 1 st in first st, p 1, (k 1, p 2) 4 times, k 1; inc 1 st in last st. **11th row:** Inc 1 st in first st, k 1, (p 1, k 2) 5 times; p 1. **12th row:** Same as 4th row. The last 4 rows constitute the pattern. **Keeping continuity of pattern throughout all shaping,** inc 1 st at side edge each row and 1 st at front edge every other row until there are 33 sts on needle. Break yarn and place sts onto a stitch holder.

**LEFT POINT . . .** Same as Right Point, reversing shaping. Do not break off.

**BODY . . .** **Next row:** Inc 1 st in first st (side edge), work in pattern across, cast on 1 st (center front), work in pattern across sts of Right Point, increasing 1 st in last st (69 sts).

Cast on 3 sts at end of each row until there are 183 sts on needle. Cast on 21 sts at end of next 2 rows. Inc 1 st at both ends of every other row until there are 249 sts on needle. (Work should be at right back edge.) On the next row make a buttonhole as follows: *Work 2 sts, bind off 6 sts, work in pattern across row. On next row, work in pattern, casting on 6 sts to replace those bound off.* Work straight in pattern for 2½ inches, making another buttonhole 1½ inches above 1st buttonhole.

Bind off 12 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of each row until 123 sts remain. Work straight until piece measures 13 inches from center top of the two points, ending with the 3rd row. **Next row:** Work in pattern across 61 sts, bind off next st (center st), work in pattern across remaining 61 sts. Working over the last set of sts only, dec 1 st at both ends of every other row until 33 sts remain, ending at inner edge. **Following row:** (K 2 tog) 16

times, k 1, work straight in pattern over the remaining sts until piece measures 5 inches. **Next row:** Work 2 sts, bind off 4 sts, work 4 sts, bind off 4 sts, work remaining 2 sts. On the following row, cast on 4 sts over each of the 4 sts bound off. Work straight in pattern for ½ inch. Bind off.

Attach yarn at inner edge on opposite side and work to correspond, omitting buttonholes.

Make a row of sc all around edges, making 3 sc in each corner and holding sides of vest in to fit tightly. Press through a damp cloth. Sew buttons opposite buttonholes.

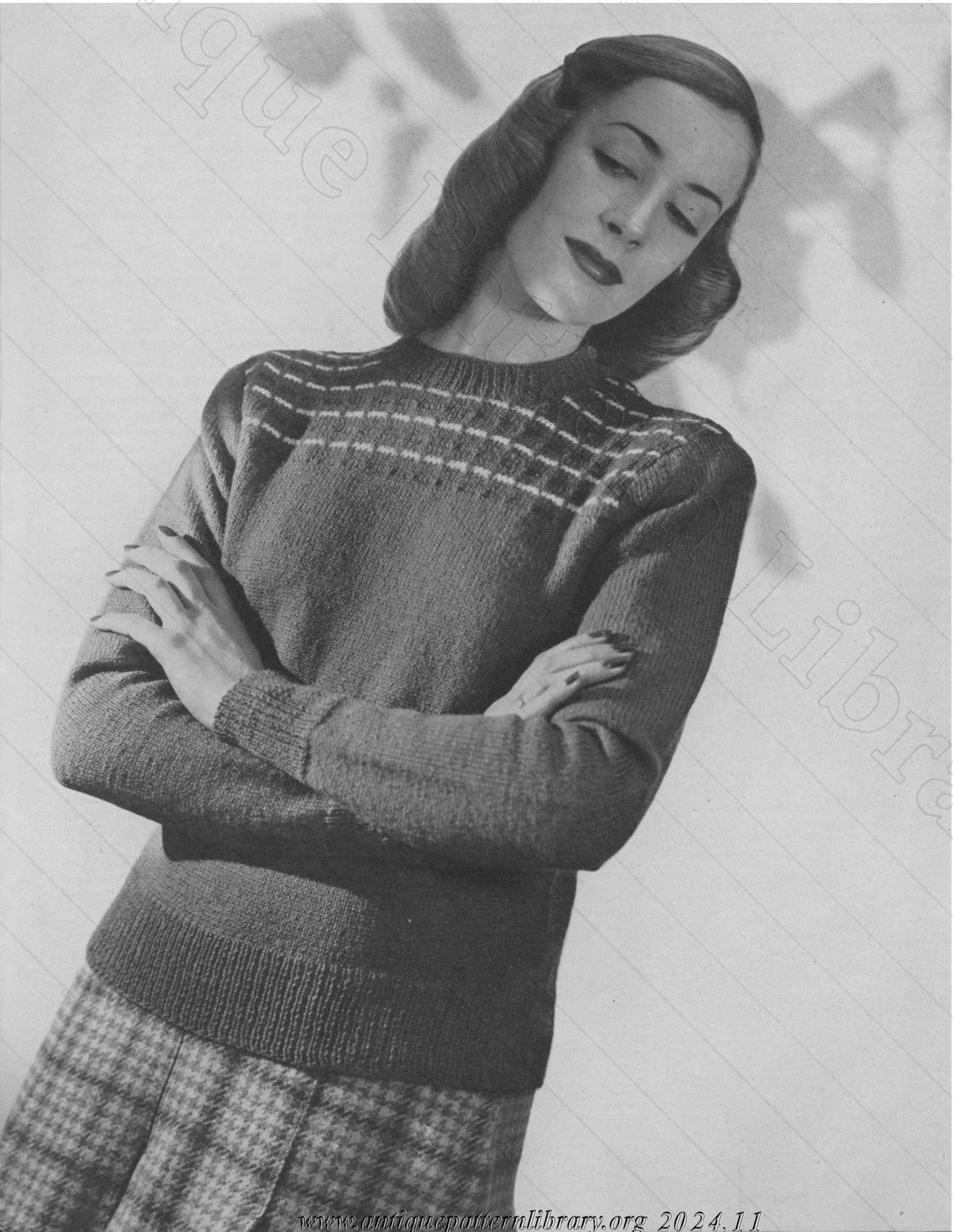

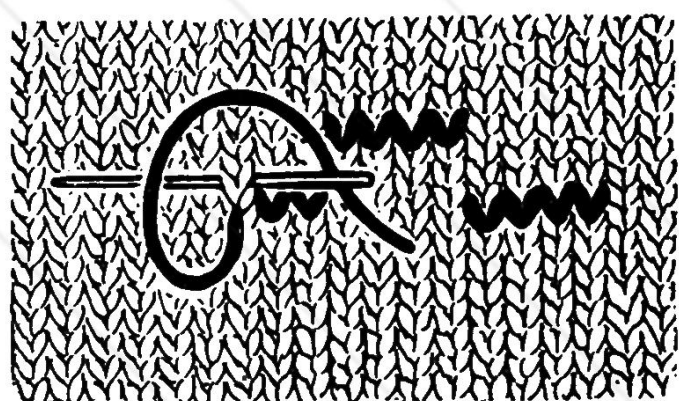

**To Shape Top:** Bind off 6 sts at beginning of next 2 rows and 2 sts at beginning of following 4 rows. Dec 1 st at end of each row until there remain

64 sts 65 sts 65 sts

Dec 1 st at both ends of next row and every 3rd row thereafter until there remain

44 sts 45 sts 45 sts

Bind off 3 sts at beginning of the next 8 rows. Bind off remaining

20 sts 21 sts 21 sts

Press pieces through damp cloth. Sew side and shoulder seams. Sew sleeve seams and sew sleeves in. Sew in shoulder pads.

**NECKBAND** . . . With right side facing, pick up and knit

134 sts 136 sts 138 sts

Work in ribbing of k 1, p 1 for 1 inch. Bind off in ribbing.

Work a row of sc along back opening, making two ch-3 buttonloops on left edge. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonloops.
