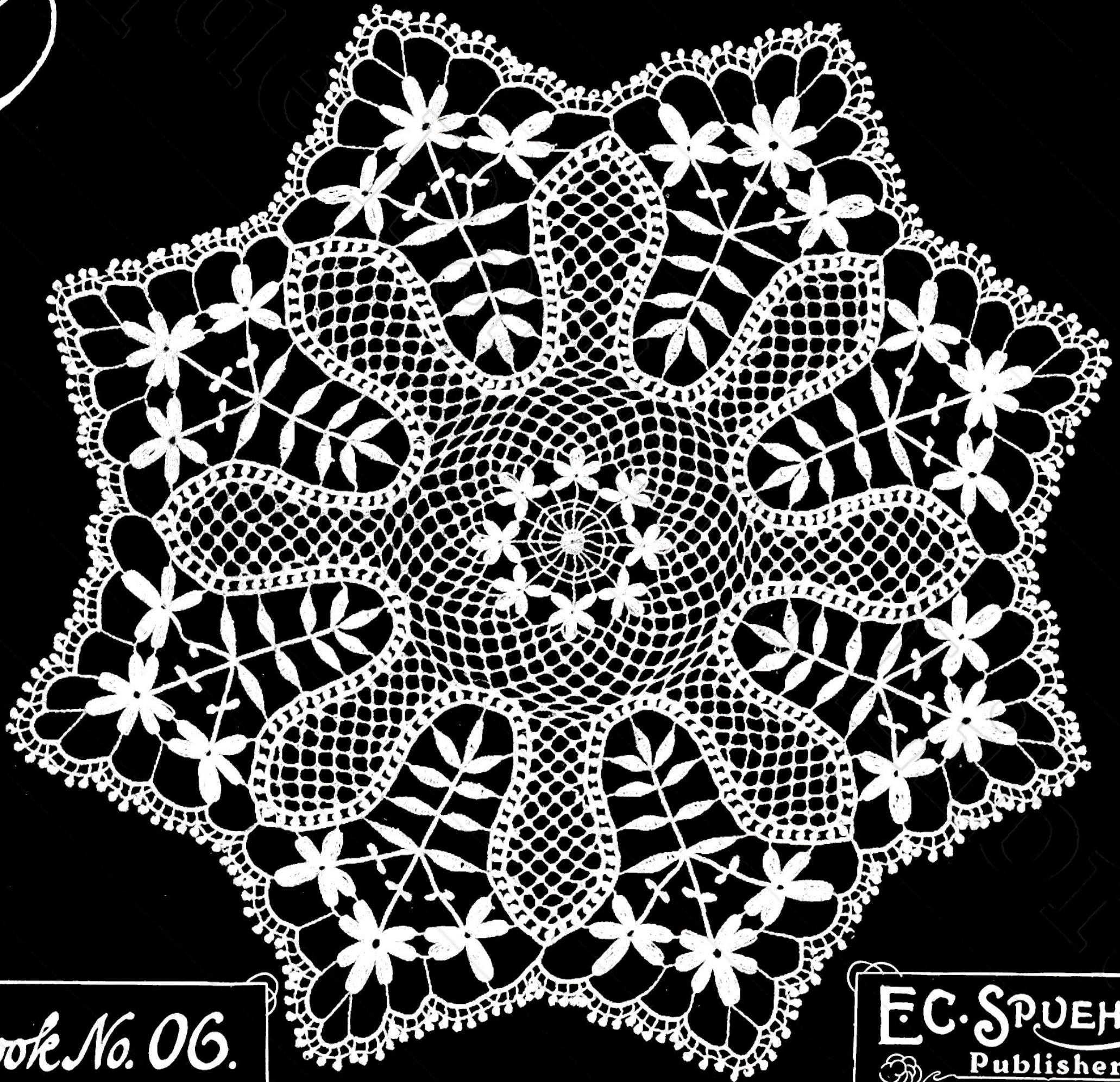

Center Pieces, Lemonade Sets, Doilies

**WILD ROSE DESIGN No. 1**  
No. 20 cotton, No. 10 hook.

Ch 192 for 12 scallops-add 16 ch for each additional scallop-join.

1st Round—Ch 5-sk 1st on foundation-1 tc in next-\* ch 2-sk 1 st-1 tc in next-repeat from \* around ch 2-j to 3rd st on 1st 5 ch.

2nd Round—Make pl-sk 1 tc-sl st in next tc-repeat around ending with hpl and ttc with p.

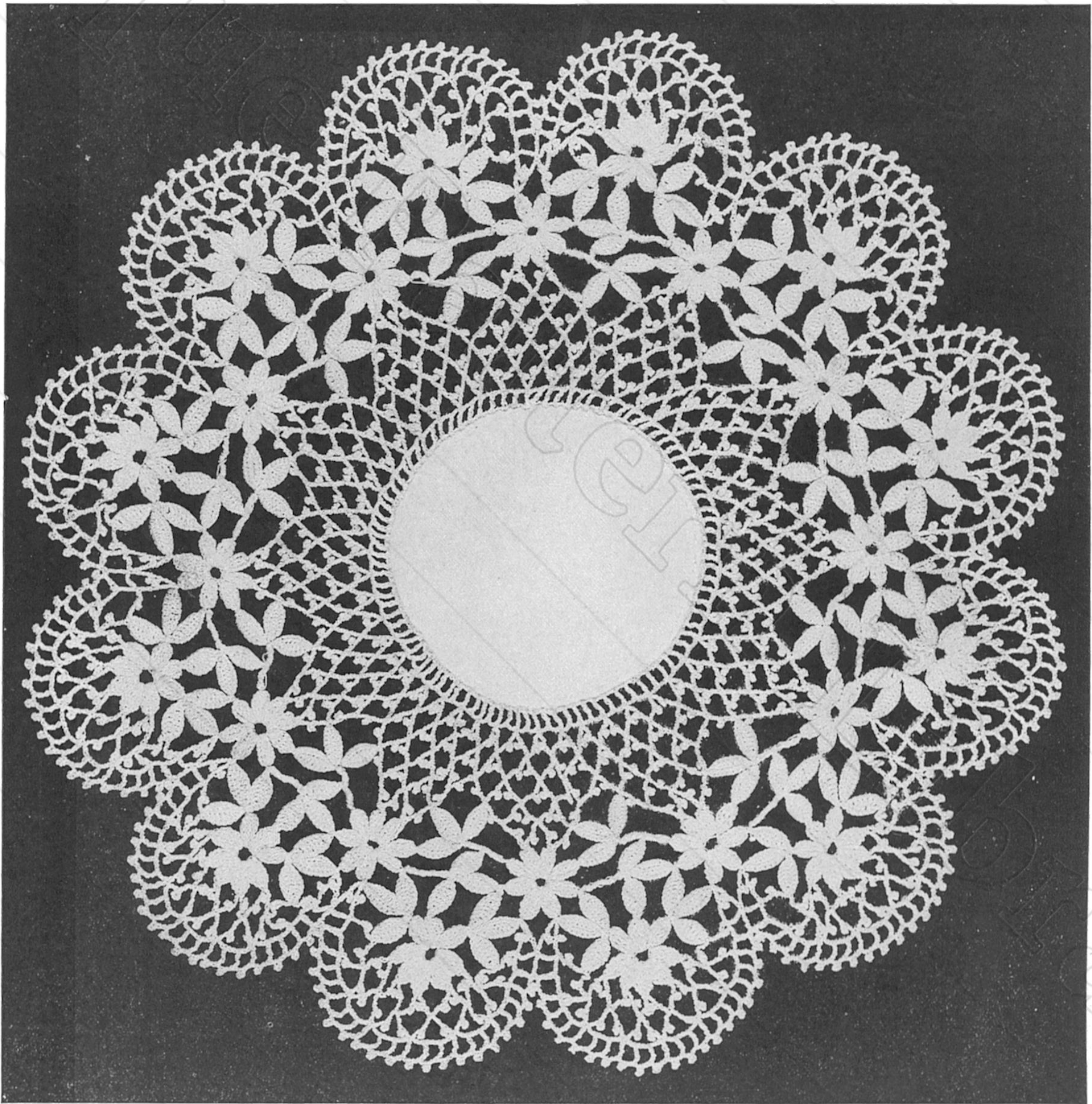
3rd and 4th Rounds—Same as second.

5th Round—2 pl-1 hpl-ttc with p to next pl-ch 11-turn-1 sc in second st from hook 1 hdc-5 dc-1 hdc-1 sc-sl st in last-ch 1-turn-sk 1 st-1 sc in each remaining st on leaf. (This will be termed as double leaf hereafter (dl.). Ch 1-make another leaf same as 1st leaf-j with sl st to ctr of next pl-repeat around making last leaf by ch 11-j to foot of first pl

next st on eyelet of next rose-sl st to opposite side of eyelet 1 sp-repeat from \* sl st back over last st.

8th Round—Turn-1 sp-\* pl (5 ttc) in last st on eyelet. This will be termed as treble petal (tp) 1 dl-1 sl-j between sp-and dl-on row below 1 sp and eyelet 1 sp-j to tip of loose sl of row below-1 sp in next st on eyelet 1 sl-j between stem and sp of row below 1 dl-1 tp in next st in eyelet of next rose-repeat from \* around and turn.

9th Round—1 pl-1 sl-j between sp and dl of previous row 1 pl-tp-in next st on eyelet-repeat last four more times-1 pl-1 sl-j between sp and dl on row below 1 hpl-ttc with p to tip of same leaf-turn-ch 8-\* ttc with p to ctr of next pl-ttc with p to same st-repeat from \* 5 more times-ch 8-sl st in ctr of next pl \*-ch 5-sl st to next ch 4-tc in ctr of last 8 ch-ch 5-p back in 5th stitch from hook-ch 2-tc over ttc with p-repeat last 19 times forming edge over scallop as shown in illustration.

on row (ch 1-turn-1 sc-1 hdc-1 dc-3 tc-1 dc-1 hdc-1 sc-1 sl st). This will be termed as single leaf (sl).

6th Round—\* (ch 1-draw loop one inch long-thread over-draw another loop in same st-same length-repeat until you have 5 ls on hook-twist ls 5 times-thread over-draw off all ls at once-ch 1 to tighten). This will be termed as stem. (Ch 8-4 ttc back in last st on stem holding last 1 each time-draw all off at once). This will be termed as single petal (sp). Ch 7-loose ch for eyelet-j to where all ls were drawn off for sp-ch 8-ttc with p in ctr of 1st pl of previous row-finish sp in next st on eyelet-hpl to ctr of next pl-hpl-ttc with p to next l-sp in next st on eyelet ending petal in eyelet-sl st in next st on eyelet-1 dl-j to ch between 2 next leaves-repeat from \* break.

7th Round—J thread in next st on eyelet-make sp-\* 1 stem 1 sl-j to ctr of stem of previous row-1 sl-1 dl-1 sp-in

**LEMONADE SET NO. 2**

No. 20 cotton, No. 10 hook.

1st Round—Sc all around linen-12 sc to each scallop.

2nd Round—Ch 10, slst back in 5th, form picot, sk 2 sts-1 dc in next-\* ch 5-slst in 4th, form p-ch 2-sk 2 sts-1 dc in next-repeat from \* around-join with sl st to p.

3rd Round—Ch 7-sl st back in 5th st from hook-ch 2-sl st in same p \* ch 5-dtc in same-ch 9-sl st back in 5th st from hook-ch 5-sl st in top of last 1 tc-ch 5-sl st in ring-ch 5-2 ttc in ring-fasten to 2nd p-1 ttc in ring-ch 5-sl st in ring-ch 5-2 ttc in ring-dtc in 2nd p-ch 2-sl st in ctr of dtc-ch 2-sl st in p-repeat from \* all around-sl st to top of tc.

4th Round—\* ch 5-dtc over dtc-dtc over next dtc-ch 5-sl st at foot of dtc-1 tc in ring-ch 5-sl st in ring-thus finishing 3rd petal-make 2 more petals in ring-ch 5-tc in ring-repeat from \* around-sl st to top of dtc-5th round-ch 4 \* dtc

over 1st petal-ch 4-thread over hook 7 times-insert hook between next 2 petals-leaving off 2 loops at a time until all are taken off-ch 8-thread over hook 5 times-catch  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the way down in long ttc-ch 4-tc in next petal-ch 4-sl st between the 2 dtc-ch 4-repeat from \* around.

6th Round—\* 8 sc over the 4 ch-turn-ttc on opposite 4 ch at angle over tc of 4th row-8 sc over next 4 ch-thread over hook six times-insert hook on opposite scallop over ttc-16 sc in 8 ch at point-8 sc over next ch-repeat from \* around.

7th Round—Ch 6-dtc in 3rd st-\* ch 7-sl st back in 4th st to form p-ch 3-dc in ctr of dtc-ch 3-sk space of 2 ch on lttc-1 tc in next-ch 3-sk same space-1 dtc in next-repeat from \* around. Small doilies are made same with only 11 scallops.

## LARGE DAISY CENTERPIECE, NO. 3

No. 30 cotton, No. 12 hook.

22 inches—linen.

1st Round—Work 1248 sc on linen-join.

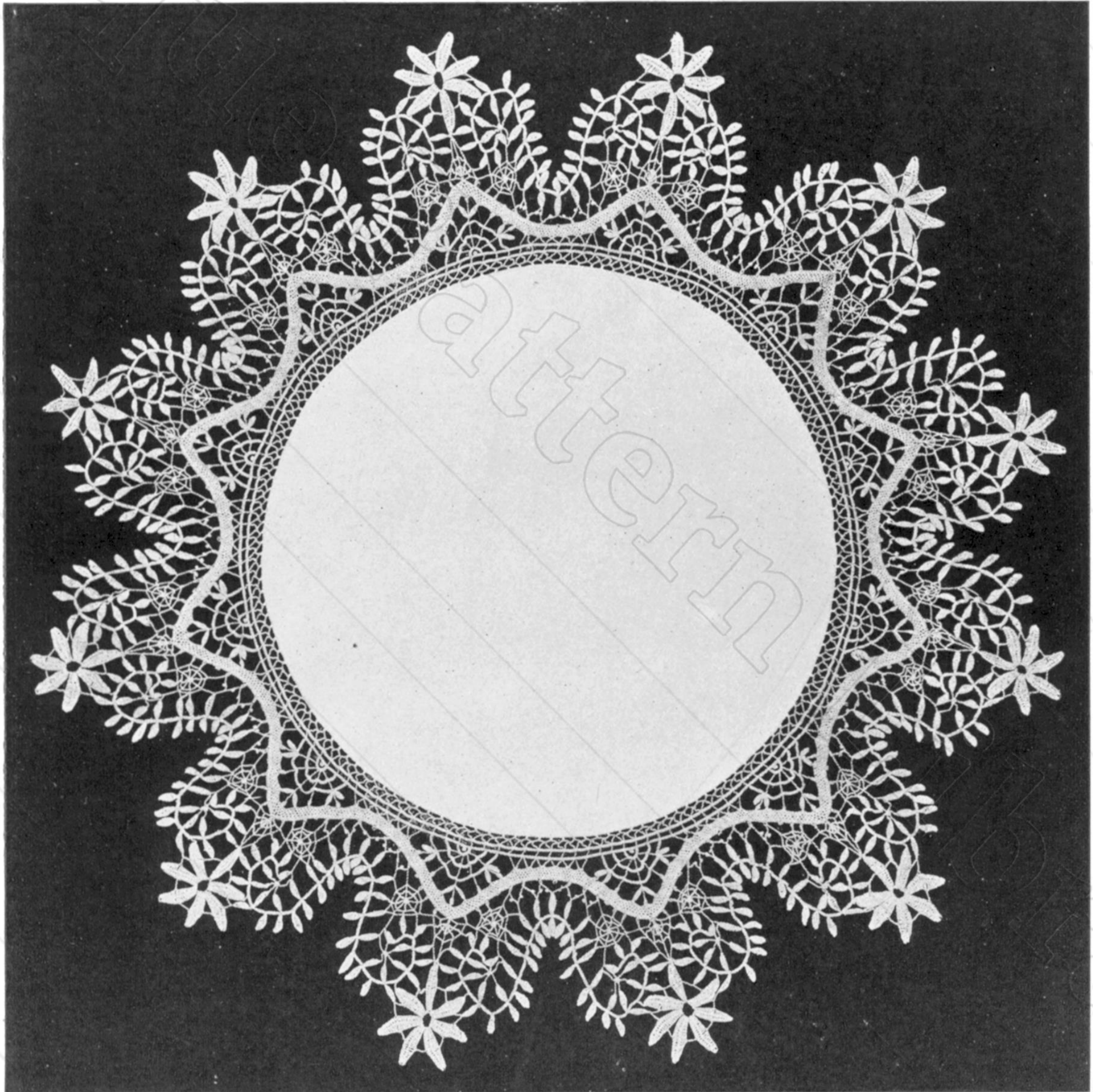
7th Round—Fasten thread in 3rd sp from p over tc of previous row-ch 6-\* sk 10 sc-ttc over tc-ch 7-ttc in foot of ttc-repeat 4 more times omitting 6 ch-ch 7-ttc with p between the 2 petals-ch 7-sl st in point of petal-ch 7-sk 12 sc-ttc with p over ttc with p-ch 23-tc in point of scallop-make petal in last 11 ch-ch 12-ttc with p at foot of petal-ch 23-sl st at foot of petal-turn-make petal on last 11 ch-ch 12-sk 12 sc-ttc with p in next-ch 11-sl st over point of petal-ch 7-ttc with p between petals ch 7-ttc over tc-repeat from \* around-join.

8th Round—Ch 3-sk 1 st on ch-sl st in next-repeat around.

9th-10th-11th-12th Rounds—Same as 8th round.

13th Round—\* 1 sc in each of 6 loops-ch 3-sl st back in first st to form p-repeat from \* around-sl st to top of p.

14th Round—\* 5 pls-fasten to each p of previous row-missing 1 p in ctr-ch 15-join to 3rd st from hook-turn-ch 7-

2nd Round—Ch 9-\* sk 7 sts on 1st round-1 sc in next-ch 8-repeat from \* around ending with ttc.

3rd Round—Ch 5-ttc in center of next loop-\* ch 5-ttc in same loop-ttc in next loop-ch 5-repeat from \* around.

4th Round—10 sc under each loop of 5 ch-join.

5th Round—Ch 8-sk 10 sc-tc in next-\* ch 5-sk 10 sc-tc in next-repeat from \* around.

6th Round—\* Fill 2 loops of 5 ch with 10 sc-5 sc in next loop-p of 4 ch-5 sc in same loop-ch 10-turn-sk 10 sc-sl st over tc of previous row-turn-17 sc in loop just made-10 sc in next ch of 5-ch 5-sk 3 sc-ttc in next-ch 5-repeat 4 times ending with 5 chs-sl st over next tc of previous row-turn-10 sc under each 5 ch-10 sc on next loop-turn-ch 8-ttc over ttc of previous row-repeat 4 times-ending with 8 ch-sl st over next tc-turn-12 sc under first loop-ch 11-1 sc in 2nd st from hook-1 hdc-5 dc-1 hdc-1 sc-sl st in last-ch 11-make another petal-12 sc in each of next 4 loops-make 2 more petals same as first-12 sc in next loop-10 sc under each of next 8 loops-repeat from \* around-join-break.

tc in loop of 3 ch-ch 4-tc in same 1-repeat last 5 times-crossing 15 ch-ch 4-sl st to 3rd st on 7 ch-ch 10-dtc over tc-ch 7-dc over tc-repeat 3 more times-ch 7-dc in 2nd p of previous row-dc over tc-repeat last once more-j to next p-ch 7-sl st to 3rd st on 10 ch-ch 7-dc in next p of previous row-ch 7-sl st in point of scallop-sl st to other side of p-turn-ch 6-dc in p-ch 3-dc in same p-repeat 4 times-tc in ctr of 7 ch-ch 4-tc over dc-ch 4-ttc over dc-ch 4-repeat last 3 times-ch 4-ttc in ctr of 6 ch-dc to next p-make another spider same as other side-then repeat from \* around-break.

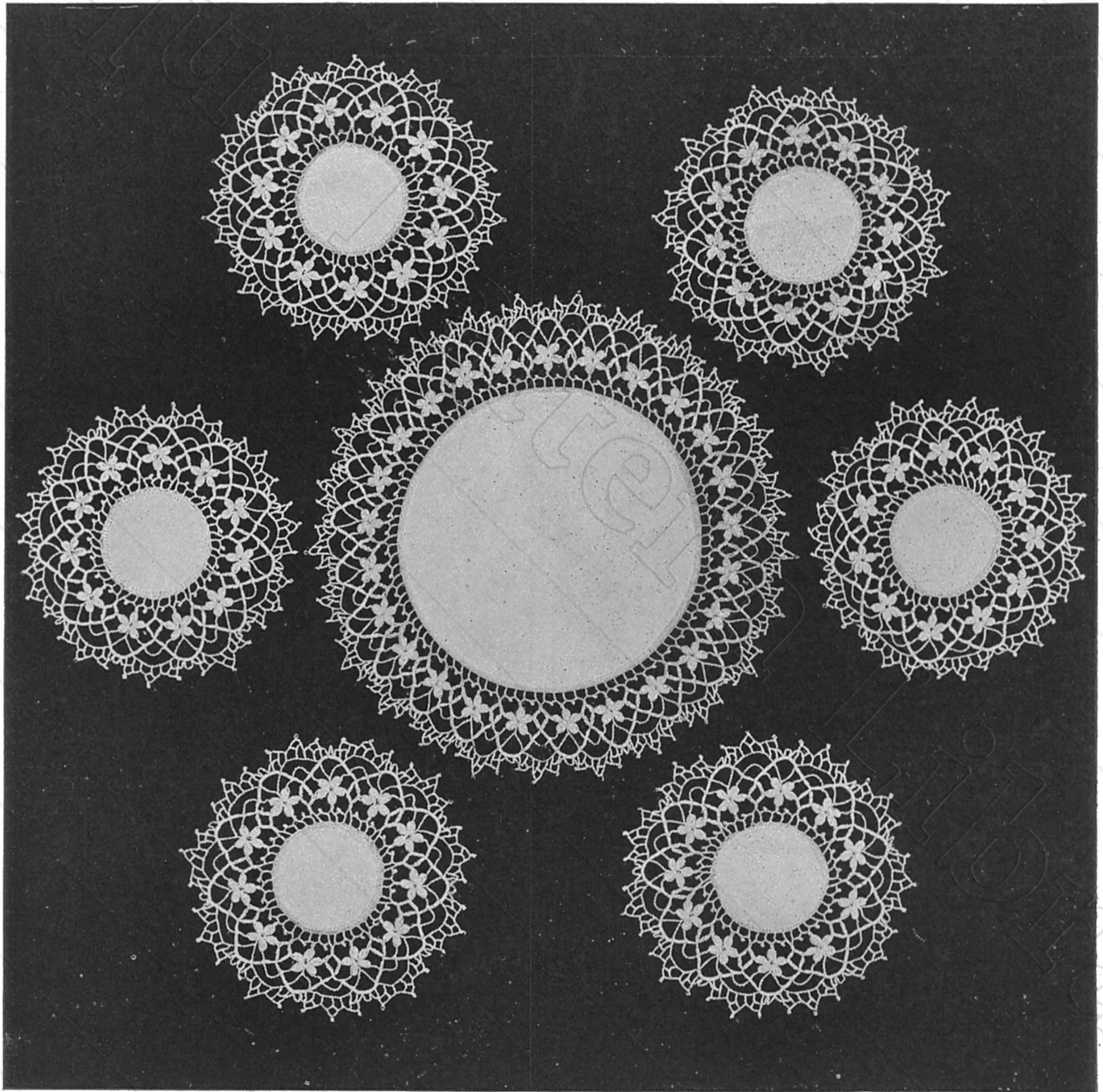
15th Round—Ch 11-turn-make petal on 11 ch-ch 29-sl st in 3rd st from hook to form ring-sl st over the 1st 3 ch-make petal over next 10 ch-ch 19-dc in ring-turn-make petal over last 11 ch-ch 19-dc in ring-turn-make petal-ch 19-tc in ring-turn-make petal-ch 19-ttc in ring-thread over 6 times-insert hook over 3rd dc-back to right of last 7 ch of first spider web made-leave off 2 loops at a time 4 times-insert hook in point of 1st petal made-leave off remaining sts 2 at a

time-turn-make leaf-ch 15-tc in same st-tc in next dc on spider-turn-make petal-ch 14-dtc over next dc on spiderweb-ttc over pl-turn-make petal-ch 14-join to ctr of next pl-turn-make petal-ch 14-sl st in top of next pl-turn-make petal-reverse other side-4 sc over ch-ch 11-sl st over dc on spiderweb-turn-make petal 4 sc-ch 4-ttc over dc on spiderweb-ch 6-ttc in dc on spiderweb over scallop-turn-make petal-6 sc-ch 11-tc over next tc-turn-make petal-4 sc-ch 11-ttc at point of last petal-dttc over ctr of spider-turn-make petal-4 sc-ch 11-turn-make petal-10 sc-ch 11-turn-make petal-4 sc-ch 11-turn-repeat petal with 4 sc between for 9 times-then reverse pattern-break.

Daisy Point—Ch 21-join-ch 21-turn-1 sc-1 dc-1 tc-17 dtc in each st-sk 2 sts on ring-sl st in next-ch 21-repeat 6 times-having 7 petals in all-joining each petal together with a ttc-break-j to petals and between as shown in illustration.

back across petal-ch 14-1 dc in point of petal where stem is joined-ch 21-sl st on first petal of next daisy-turn-8 sc in 8 ch-begin petal-1 sc-1 hdc-1 dc-6 tc-1 dc-1 hdc-1 sc-sl st in last-sl st over dc-make another petal same as first over 1st 14 sts-turn-ch 22-sl st between the two petals-turn-1 sc in each last 9 sts-ch 13-sl st in point of next petal. Ch 14-make another petal-sl st back on petal-ch 14 for another petal made same as last-ch 14-sl st between the two 13 ch-turn-make petal. Ch 14-make another petal-on point between the two petals-make 4 roll sts-ch 3-wrap thread 30 times over needle for roll and j-each roll with sl st to next st on petal to form 1-3 roll sts between the 4 roll sts and 2 between the 3 roll sts-this forms point of scallop-sl st across last petal- ch 14-sl st at point of 1st petal made. Make 9 roll sts same as at point between the two petals-sl st to the 13 ch-1 sc in each st across both 13 ch-ch 14-make another petal-make ?



LEMONADE SET, NO. 2

LUNCHEON SET, NO. 4

8 inch linen center.  
 1st Round—Ch 280. Join.  
 2nd Round—Sc in each st.  
 3rd Round—\* Ch 6-ttc back in same st-sk 6 sts-1 ttc in next-ch 6-sl st in same st-repeat from \* around-sl st back to top of 6 ch.  
 4th Round—Ch 8-sl st between the 2 ttc-ch 8-repeat around.  
 5th Round—1 sc in each ch-\* ch 6-sl st back in first of 6 ch-turn-12 sc in ring-8 sc in next 8 ch-repeat from \* around.  
 6th Round—Same as 3rd round in Plate Doily.  
 7th Round—Same as 4th round in Plate Doily.  
 8th Round—Same as 5th round in Plate Doily.  
 With the exception of 10 ch instead of 8 ch-1 ttc more in each petal-and 18 ch in stem-sl st to top of petal.  
 9th Round—\* ch 21-sl st to point of petal where stem is j-turn-8 sc-under last 8 ch-make leaf on remaining sts-sl st

more roll sts between the 2 petals-sl st across last petal made-repeat from \*.

12 INCH PLATE DOILY

Linen center—4 inches.  
 1st Round—Ch 168.  
 2nd Round—6 sc-\* ch 8-sl st back in first st-turn-16 sc in loop just made-6 sc in next 6 sts-repeat from \* around-sl st to top of loop.  
 3rd Round—Ch 16-sl st to next loop-ch 16-repeat around.  
 4th Round—\* 16 sc over 8 ch-ch 6-sl st back in first st of 6 ch-turn-fill loop with 12 dc-16 sc over next 8 ch-repeat from \* around-sl st to top of loop.  
 5th Round—Ch 9-sl st back in 5th st to form ring-ch 5-sl st to 5 ch-2 tc in ring-ch 5-sl st in ring-make another petal-ch 6-sc back in each of 6 ch-make another petal in ring-\* ch 11-sl st in 5th to form ring-ch 5-2 ttc in ring-sl st in top of next loop-1 ttc in ring-ch 5-sl st in ring-make another petal-sl st over the 6 ch-turn-sc back in each st-form another petal in ring-repeat from \* around.

6th Round—Ch 16—turn—\* 1 sc in 2nd st from hook—1 hdc—1 dc—6 tc—1 dc—1 hdc—1 sc—sl st in next—turn—sl st back in each st—ttc in 3rd petal—ch 14—make another petal same as first—make 4 roll sts between these two petals—3 roll sts over the four and 2 over the three—sl st on the wrong side—ch 14—1 dc over 3rd petal—turn—make another petal same as last—sl st back over petal—ch 14—repeat from \* around.

**Platter Dolly**

Linen—4 inches wide, 7 inches long.  
Same as Plate Dolly.

**Bread and Butter Plate Dolly**

Linen—4½ inches wide.  
1st Round—Ch 220—join.  
2nd Round—10 sc—\* ch 9—sl st back in 5th st for ring—ch 5—sl st to top of 5 ch—ch 5—sl st in ring—ch 5—2 ttc in ring—ch 7—turn—1 sc in each st to end—1 ttc in ring—ch 5—sl st in ring—ch 5—3 ttc in ring—ch 5—sl st in ring—ch 5—sl st in point of next petal—1 ttc in ring—this finishes 3rd petal. 10 sc in next 10 sts—repeat from \* around.  
3rd Round—Same as last round in Plate Dolly.

**Napkin**

1st Round—Fasten in napkin—\* ch 9—sl st back in 5th st from hook to form ring—ch—3 ttc in ring—ch 5—sl st back in ring—make two more petals like first—ch 4—sk about ¼ in—sl st in napkin—ch 9—repeat from \* around.

2nd Round—1 sc in each st on the 4 ch—ch 5—place ch on wrong side of work—4 sc in next 4 sts—repeat around.

**SCROLL DESIGN NO. 5**

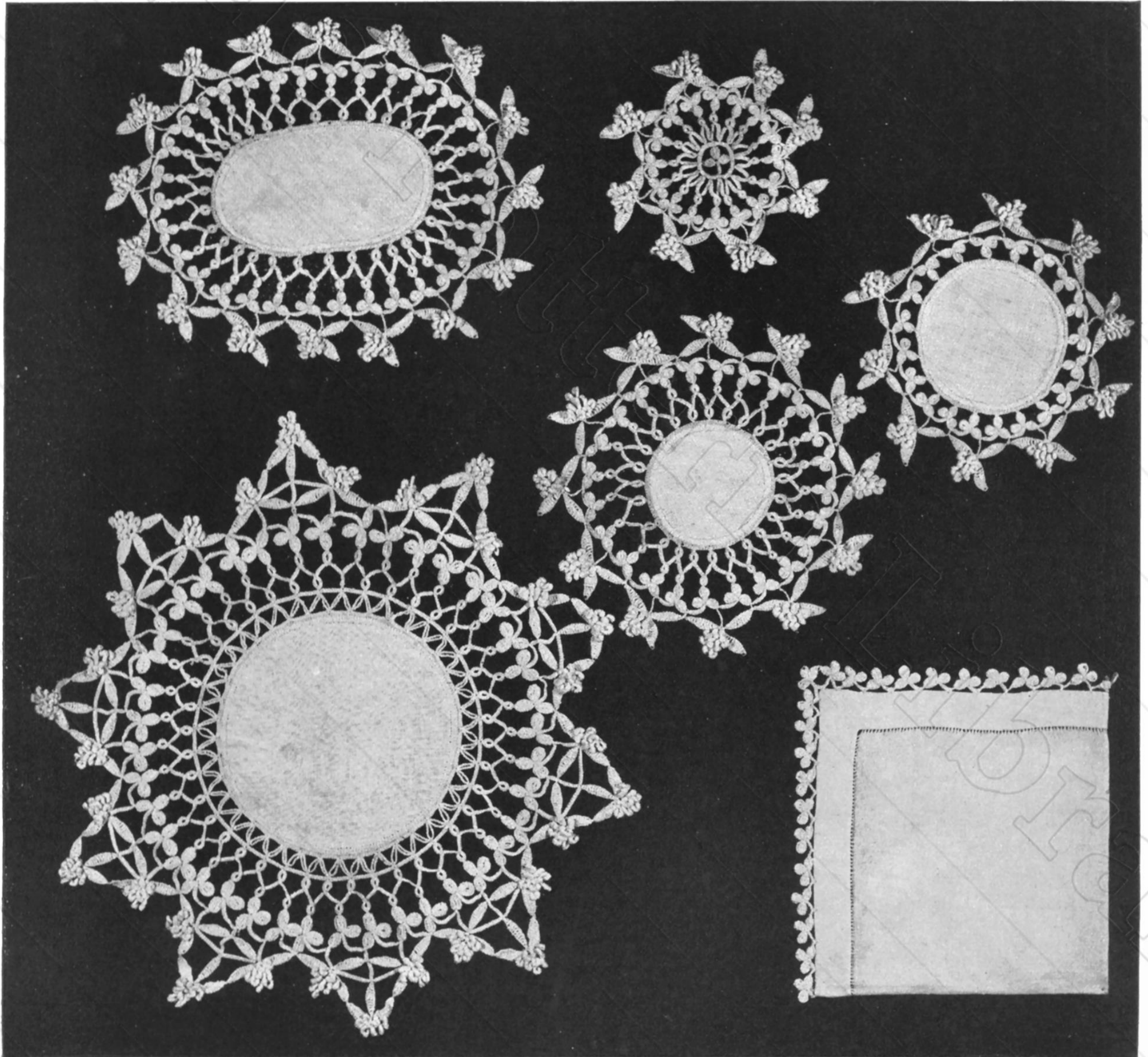
No. 15 cotton, No. 9 hook.

1st Round—Ch 3—make clones knot—repeat around until you have 128 clones knots—j—sl st to top of clones knot.

2nd Round—Ch 4—sl st in next clones knot—ch 4—repeat around.

3rd Round—Ch 3—sk 1 st—1 sc in next—repeat around—sl st to top of 1.

4th—5th—6th—7th—8th Rounds—Same as 3rd round.



LUNCHEON SET, NO. 4

**Tumbler Dolly**

1st Round—Ch 9—join to 5th st from hook for ring—ch 5—sl st to first st on ch—2 ttc in ring—ch 5—sl st in ring—ch 5—3 ttc in ring—ch 5—sl st in ring—make one more petal—sc over remaining sts.

2nd Round—Ch 8—sl st in point of petal—repeat around—join.

3rd Round—1 sc in each st.  
4th Round—Same as 3rd round in Plate Dolly.  
5th Round—Same as 4th round in Plate Dolly.  
6th Round—Same as 5th round in Plate Dolly.  
7th Round—Same as 6th round in Plate Dolly.

9th Round—Same as last—making one clones knot on every other 1—sl st to top of clones knot.

10th Round—1 round of pls—catching in every other clones knot—make last with hpl and ttc with p.

11th Round—\* make 8 pls—ch 26—turn—1 sc in 2nd st from hook—1 hdc—1 dc—5 tc—1 dc—1 hdc—1 sc—sl st in next st—ttc with p in ctr of pl made last—8 sc in next 8 ch—ch 26—turn—make clones knot back on last 12 ch from hook—ttc to foot of leaf—sl st 4 sts back over clones knot ch 9 for petal—thread over 5 times—insert hook in next st on clones knot—leave off 2 loops at a time still holding last 1—repeat 4 times—ch 9—sl st at foot of petal—sl st to next st—make another petal same—repeat until there are 4 petals—sl st to foot of clones knot ldtc on stem at foot of 1st leaf—1 sc in each st on the 14 ch—

ch 18-turn-make leaf same as 1st on last 12 sts-ldtc at foot of clones knot on flower-1 sc on each of remaining sts to foot of first 26 ch-hpl-ttc with p to foot of last leaf-hpl-j in ctr of next pl on row below-this last pl will finish 1st pl of the 8 between flower.

Make each scroll separately.

\* ch 7-make clones knot-turn.

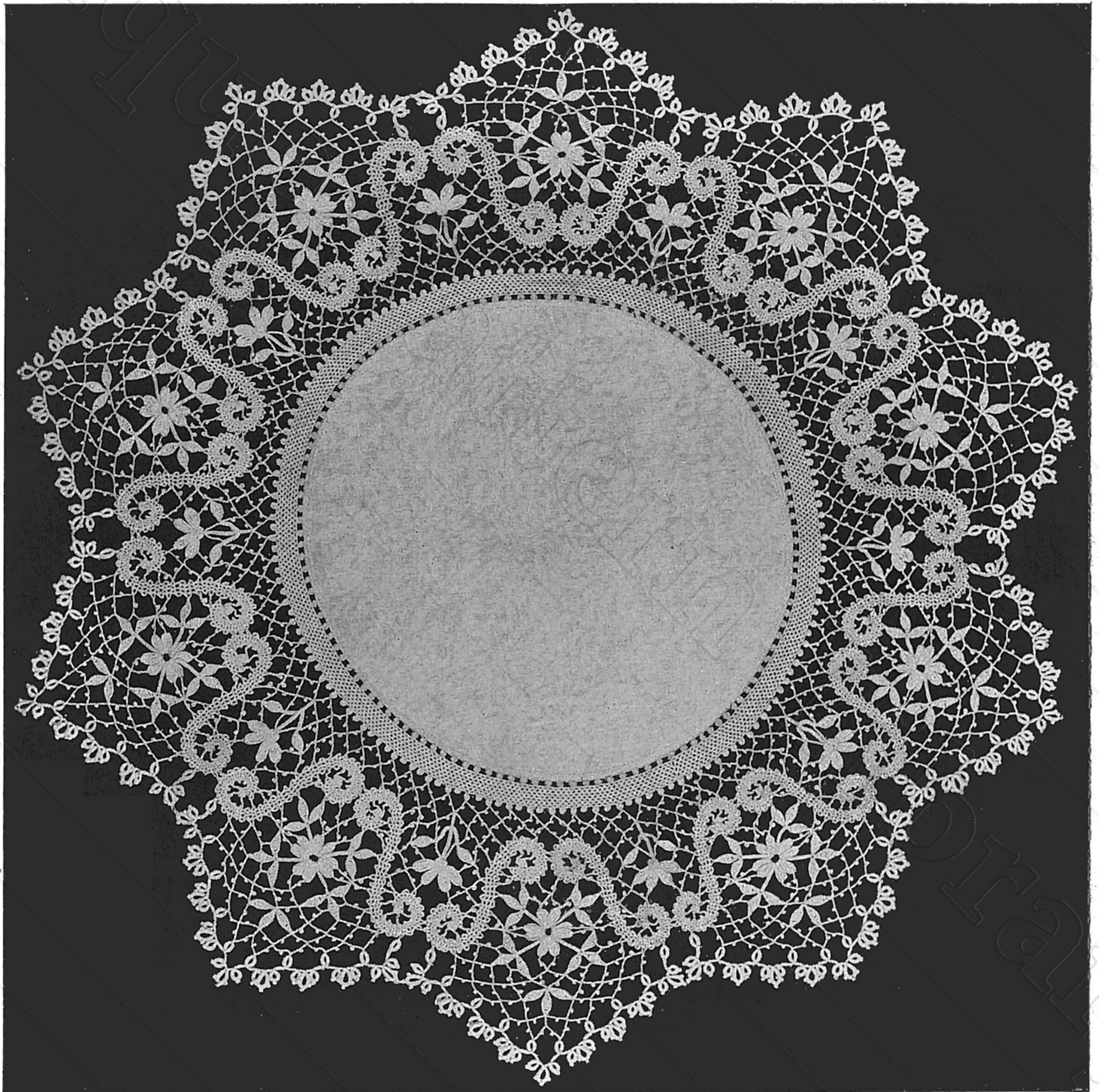
1st row—Ch 10-1 dc in 6th st on hook-ch 1-sk 1 st-1 dc in next-ch 1-sk 1-1 sc in last-ch 6-turn.

2nd Row—1 sc over 1st sc-ch 1-1 dc over next dc-ch 1-1 dc in next-ch 6-turn.

3rd Row—1 dc over dc-ch 1-dc over next dc-ch 1-sc in last-ch 2-turn.

4th Row—Sc in 1st sc-ch 1-dc in next-ch 1-1 dc in next-repeat until you have 9 rows-ending with sc on same side to shape scroll-ch 3-tc on side of clones knot-ch 3-8 rows on scroll-ttc on point of clones knot 3 rows on scroll-j to 4th

10 sts on hook-thread over-go thru all-ch 1-ch 10-ttc with p in center of pl-ch 10-thread over hook five times-insert hook in 1st st on 10 ch-leave off 2 at a time-holding 2 sts at a time-repeat 4 times-thread over-go thru all-ch 1-ch 19-ttc with p in point of last petal-ch 6-fasten in 2nd loop on scroll-turn-1 sc-1 dc-7 tc-1 dc-1 sc-sl st in last ch 11-sl st in loop at end of 42nd row on same scroll-turn-make petal same as last-ch 11-sk 1 loop on scroll-ttc with p in next-sk 1 loop on scroll-ttc with p in next loop-turn-make a petal on the 11 ch-14 sc in next 14 ch-ch 10-thread over 5 times-insert hook in first st on 10 ch-leaving two loops off at a time-holding 2 on hook-repeat 4 times-thread over-go thru all-ch 1-ch 8-p-ch 4-catch in tip of last leaf made ch 8-p-ch 14-thread over-thread over hook 5 times-catch in 10th st from hook-holding 2 on hook-repeat 4 times-thread over-go through all-j to foot of last petal with sc-ch 1-ch 25-fasten in tip of last petal-turn-make petal on 1st 11 ch-ch 7-thread

pl on the right side of flower-5 rows on scroll-ttc on opposite side of clones knot-1 row on scroll-j to next pl to left-5 rows on scrolls-ttc with p in ctr of next pl to left-1 row on scroll ending both sides with dc-tc in 1st row of scroll-4 rows on scroll-ending both sides with dc-ttc in 3rd row on side of scroll-4 rows on scroll-ttc with p within same st-2 rows on scroll still ending with dc on both sides-reverse-make other half of scroll same without joining on outside curve-break-repeat from \* joining each scroll together-placing them as shown in illustration-fill in between flower and scrolls with hpls and ttc with p-joining around flower as shown in illustration.

**FLOWER**

Fasten thread on 5th loop of scroll-ch 8-p-ch 4-ttc with p on 5th loop on opposite scroll-ch 8-p-ch 14-thread over hook 5 times-insert hook in 10th st from hook-leaving off 2 sts at a time, holding 2 sts on hook-repeat 5 times, having

over hook 6 times-sk 1 loop on scroll-leaving off two loops at a time twice-make p-leave off two loops twice-thread over twice-insert in center of last petal made-leave off two loops until all are taken off-ch 6-turn-sk 1 st on ch-make petal on remaining ch-ch 7-ttc in center of last petal made-ch 7-make another petal-sc in each of next 14 ch-ch 10-thread over 5 times-insert in first ch 10-leave off two loops at a time-holding two on hook-repeat 4 times-thread over-go thru all-ch 1-ch 8-p-ch 12-p-ch 14-thread over in 10th st on ch-holding two on hook-repeat 4 times-go thru all-ch 1-make other side same as first-break. Fasten thread in same loop on scroll where last ttc with p was joined-1 pl-sl st in point of loose petal hpl-1 pl-ttc with p in ctr of ttc between the 2 petals-hpl-sl st in point of 2nd petal-sl st in ctr of pl-hpl-sl st in point of next petal-reverse opposite side-ending with ttc with p in same l as ttc with p was joined on scroll-sk 2 ls on scroll-ttc with p in next 1-1 pl-sl st in ctr of pl-make

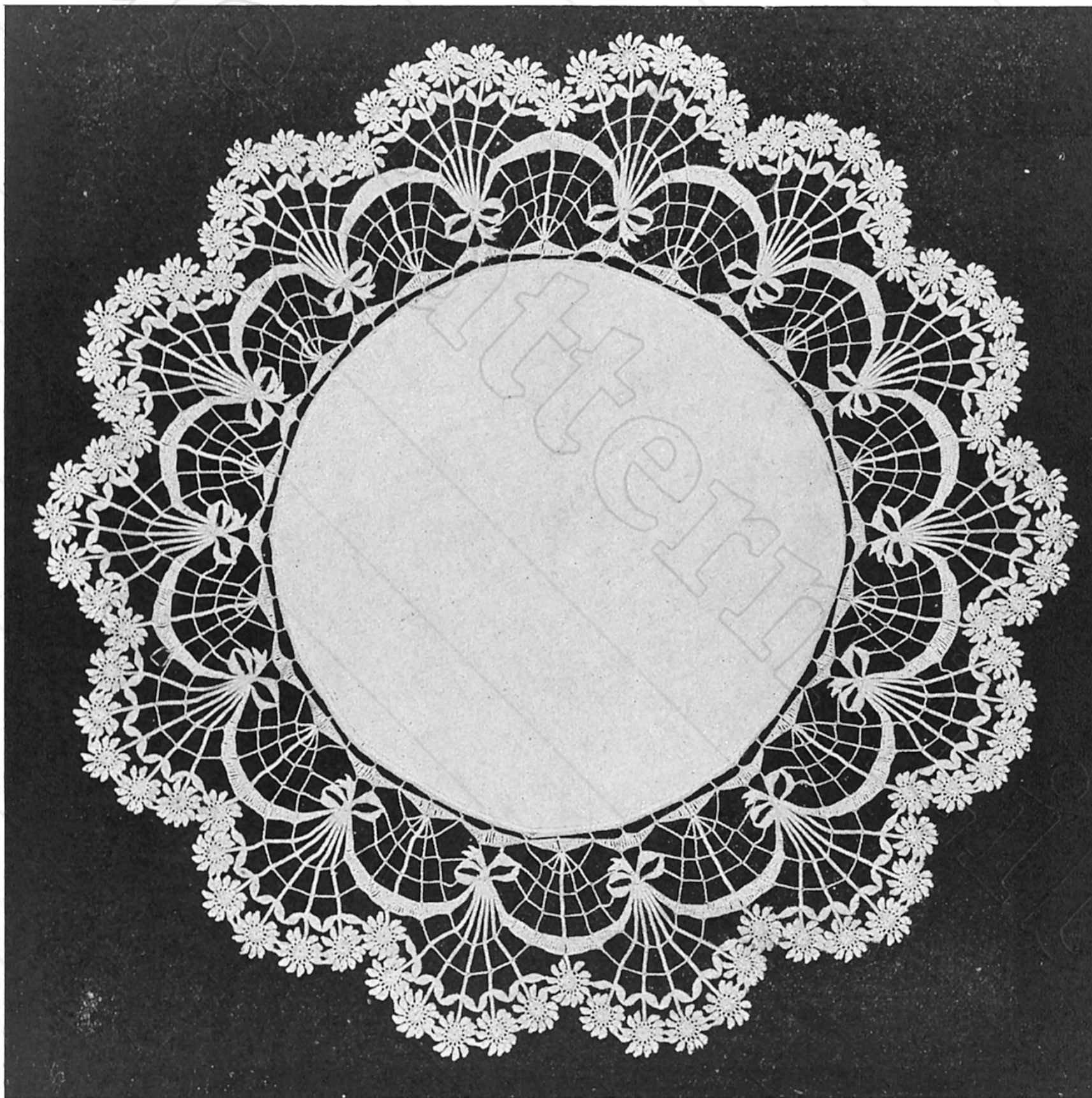
**BOW KNOT CENTERPIECE NO. 6**

No. 15 thread, No. 9 hook.

Ch 672-add 48 to each additional scallop and join.

5th Round—8 sc on crescent-4 hdc-4 dc-8 tc-8 dtc-13 ttc-1 ttc in last ttc-reverse other side of chain on crescent-sl st to bow knot-sl st on next st on bow knot. \* Chain 53-turn-1 sc in 2nd st from hook-1 hdc-5 dc-1 hdc-1 sc-forming one petal. Chain 18-Sl st in 6th st from hook-this begins medallion. Chain 3-11 dc in ring-join. Chain 8-2 tc in 4th st\*from hook-chain 4-sl st in same st where tc were made-chain 1-dc over next dc-chain 5-2 tc in 4th st from hook-chain 4-sl st back at foot of tc. Repeat all around-having 12 clusters in all. 7 sc in 7 sts on chain-chain 10-turn-make another petal same as first-7 sc in next 7 sts-sk 32 sts on crescent-ttc in next st-10 sc on next 10 sts-sk 10 sts on crescent-1 dtc in next st-sc in each st to end of chain-1 sc on next st on bow knot. Repeat from \* 4 times. Sl st to center of next crescent-chain 18-make another medallion. Sl st to next bow knot. Repeat from beginning of round to end-break.

6th Round—Fasten thread over tc on 3rd round-chain 12-ttc in center of dtc on 3rd round-chain 3-ttc in same st-chain 9-sc in same st as ttc-turn-sc in each of 1st 6 chain-make 2 more ttc in same st with 3 chain between-thread

**BOW KNOT CENTERPIECE, NO. 6**

1st Round—1 sc in each st-join.

**MEDALLION CENTERPIECE, NO. 15**

Ch 14—1 sc in 2nd st from hook—1 hdc—8 dc—1 hdc—1 sc—sl st in last—repeat 3 more times, making 4 petals—sl st back to point of last petal.

2nd Round—\* ch 8—thread over hook 5 times—insert in 7th st on petal—leaving off two loops twice—thread over—insert hook on 7th st on next petal—leave off two loops at a time until all are taken off—ch 8—sl st in point of next petal—repeat from \* all around.

3rd Round—16 sc over each ch.

4th Round—Ch 11—\* sk 5 sts—sl st in next—ch 6—sk 4 sts—sl st in next—ch 11—sk 5—sl st in next—ch 11—repeat from \* around—sl st to center of 11 ch.

5th Round—Ch 9—sl st in next ch—sl st over 1st—ch 15—\* sk loop of 6 ch—sl st in next loop—ch 9—sl st in next—ch 15—repeat from \* around—break.

6th Round—Fasten thread in center of 9 ch—ch 10—sl st in center of 15 ch—ch 10—sl st in 9th ch—repeat around.

7th Round—20 sc over the 10 ch opposite each 15 ch of previous row—make loop—ch 10—sl st to form ring—turn—fill this loop with 4 sc—p—4 sc—p—4 sc—p—4 sc—repeat all around to last loop—make 10 sc—turn—ch 6—thread over hook five times—sk 4 st on last 10 sc—made—go in 5th—leave off two loops twice—insert hook on opposite side—leave off two at a time until all are taken off—ch 7—tc in center of long ttc—ch 6—sl st in 10 st on 20 sc—turn—6 sc in last loop—made—sl st to p—6 dc in same loop—7 sc in next loop—ch 10—turn—make loop with 3 p—7 sc in same loop—6 sc in next loop—sl st to p—6 sc in same loop—10 sc in unfinished loop—break.

Ch 16—\* 1 sc in 2nd st—1 dc—3 tc—1 dc—8 sc—turn—8 sc—ch 2—sk 2 sts—dc in next—ch 2—sk 2—dc in next—ch 2—sk 2—1 dc in point—ch 5—1 dc in same st. Work on other side of ch—reversing the sts—ch 1—1 sc in each of next 8 sc—2 sc—p—2 sc in each sp—2 sc—p—2 sc—p—2 sc—p—2 sc over 5 ch—work other side to correspond—thus making a scallop—ch 18—and repeat from \*

joining the first 2 p of each scallop to the last 2 p of preceding scallop.

Top Edge

- 1st Round—Work 1 sc in each st.
- 2nd Round—1 dc-sk 1 st-repeat around.

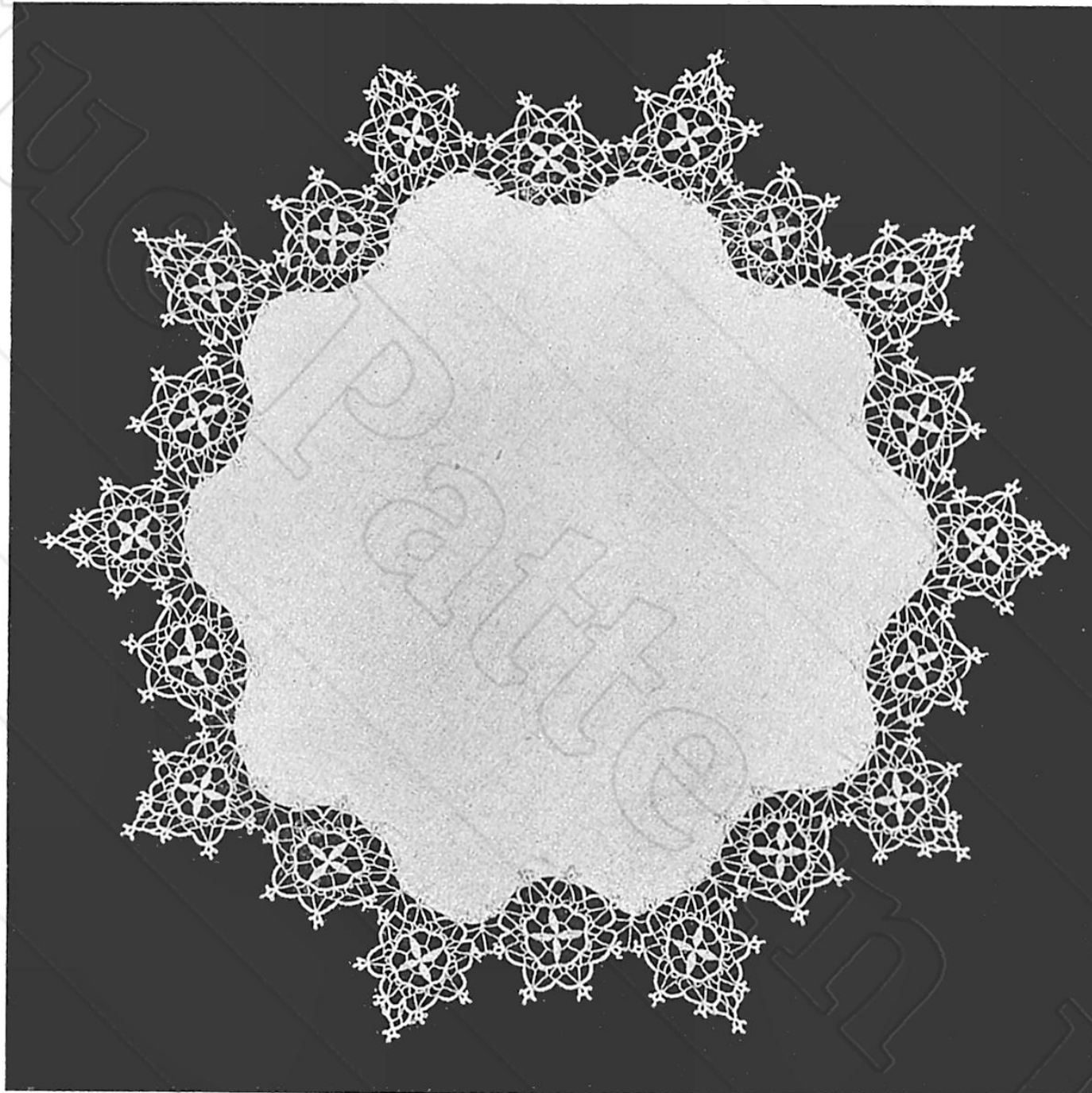

3rd Round—Ch 7-1 dc over ttc-ch 4-1 dc over next ttc-repeat around-j last 4 ch in 3rd st on 7 ch.

4th Round—Ch 10-ttc over next dc-3 ttc in 5th st from hook-ch 5-sl st back at foot of 3 ttc \* ch 5-3 ttc in same st-ch 5-sl st back in same st-repeat last petal twice-ch 5-4 ttc in same st-holding last st on needle each time-thread over and go through all-dtc over next dc of previous row-ch 5-ttc over next dc-ch 5-sl st in point of 5 ch-2 ttc at foot of ch-ch 5-sl st in same st-repeat from \* all around-break.

5th Round—Ch 4-\* dc in point of 2nd petal on next daisy-ch 7-dc in point of same petal-dc in side of ctr petal-ch 7-sl st in point of ctr petal-ch 7-dc in other side of ctr petal-dc in point of next petal-ch 7-dc in point of same petal-repeat around from \*-sl st 2 sts on 1st 7 ch.

6th Round—3 sc in 3 center sts of each loop with 7 ch between.

6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th Rounds same as 5th-then work each point separately-make 3 loops same as last row-ch 4-dc in next loop-turn-make 2 loops-ch 4-dc in next-turn-make 1 loop-ch 4-dc in next-turn-repeat last two rows 3 times-see illustration-then increase 1 loop on each side-work 2 rows-then decrease one loop each row until there are only one loop left-break-repeat from \* 7 times.

11th Round—4 sc-one in each st on ch-then make one clones knot-repeat all around-join.

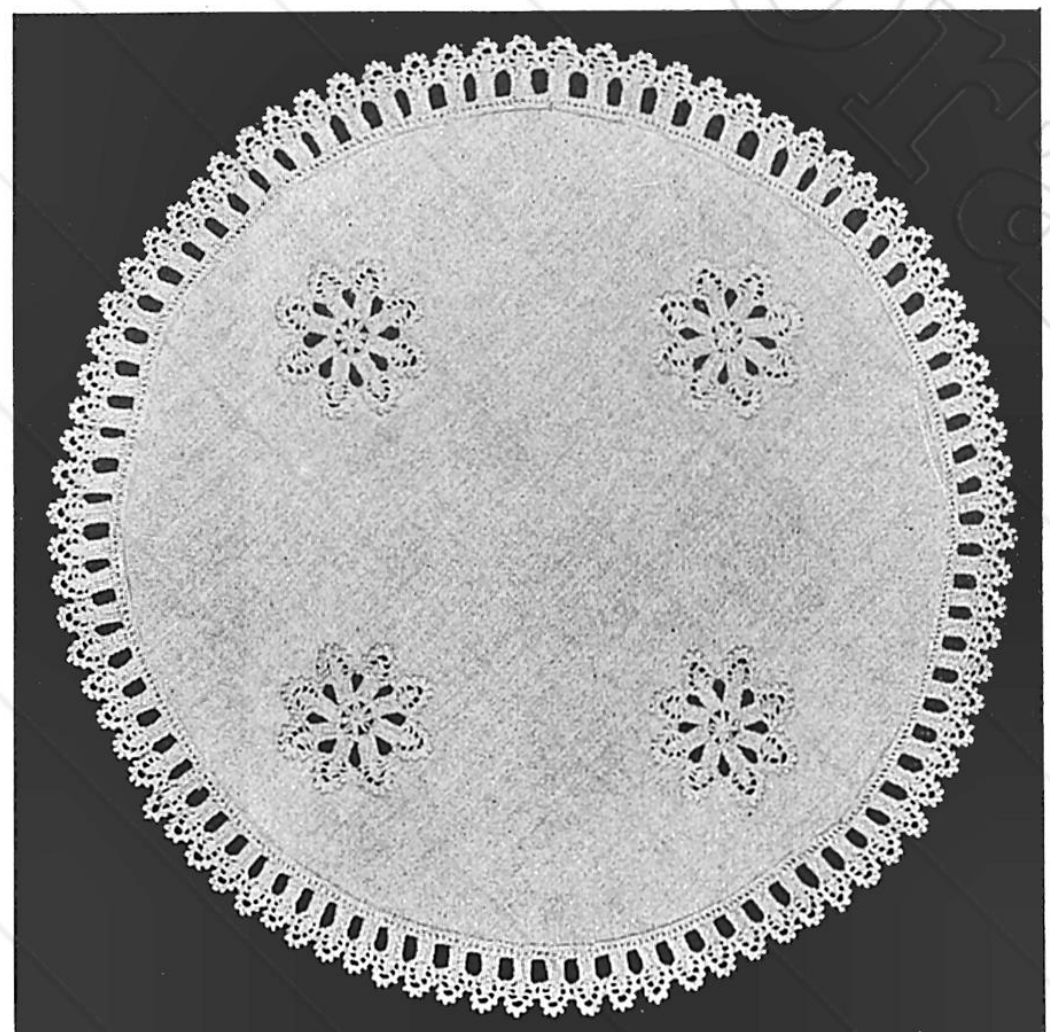

**CLONES KNOT No. 1**

Chain any desired number of chain stitches, according to size of knot wanted, about 7, for good size.

Turn, thread over hook, insert hook in second chain from hook, thread over and draw a loop. Thread over, insert hook in next chain, draw another loop a trifle longer. Repeat this last until as many chains are taken as size of knot requires. Then with thread over, draw through all loops on hook, chain 1, to tighten, slip stitch in last chain used for knot.

This makes the round, flat knot.

**CLONES KNOT No. 2**

Having work ready for the knot, either chain, double crochet, treble, or any stitch you wish to work the knot over or under.

Chain 3 for knot, turn back, insert hook in third chain from hook, thread over and draw thru. Thread over, insert hook in same chain, thread over, draw another loop, slightly longer. Repeat this last, making all loops same length, until you have as many as desired—each loop drawn makes the knot thicker—thread over and draw through all loops at once.

Then slip stitch in first chain made for knot.

**Explanation of Stitches**

Chain (ch) catch thread with hook, forming a loop; pull the thread with the hook through this loop to form first stitch; continue ch to any length desired; slip stitch (sl st) having a on the needle, just hook through work, draw through work and loop on needle at the same time.

Single crochet (sc) having a st on the needle, put hook through work, draw thread through work (making two loops on hook) thread over needle and pull through both loops.

Half double crochet (hdc) having a st on needle, thread over, insert hook in st, thread over, and pull through all three loops at one time.

Double crochet (dc) thread over hook, insert hook in st and pull thread through; having three loops on hook, thread over, pull through two loops, thread over and pull through last two.

Treble crochet (tc) like double crochet—only thread over 2 times—leaving 2 ls 3 times.

Double treble crochet (dtc) same as dc—only thread over 3 times.

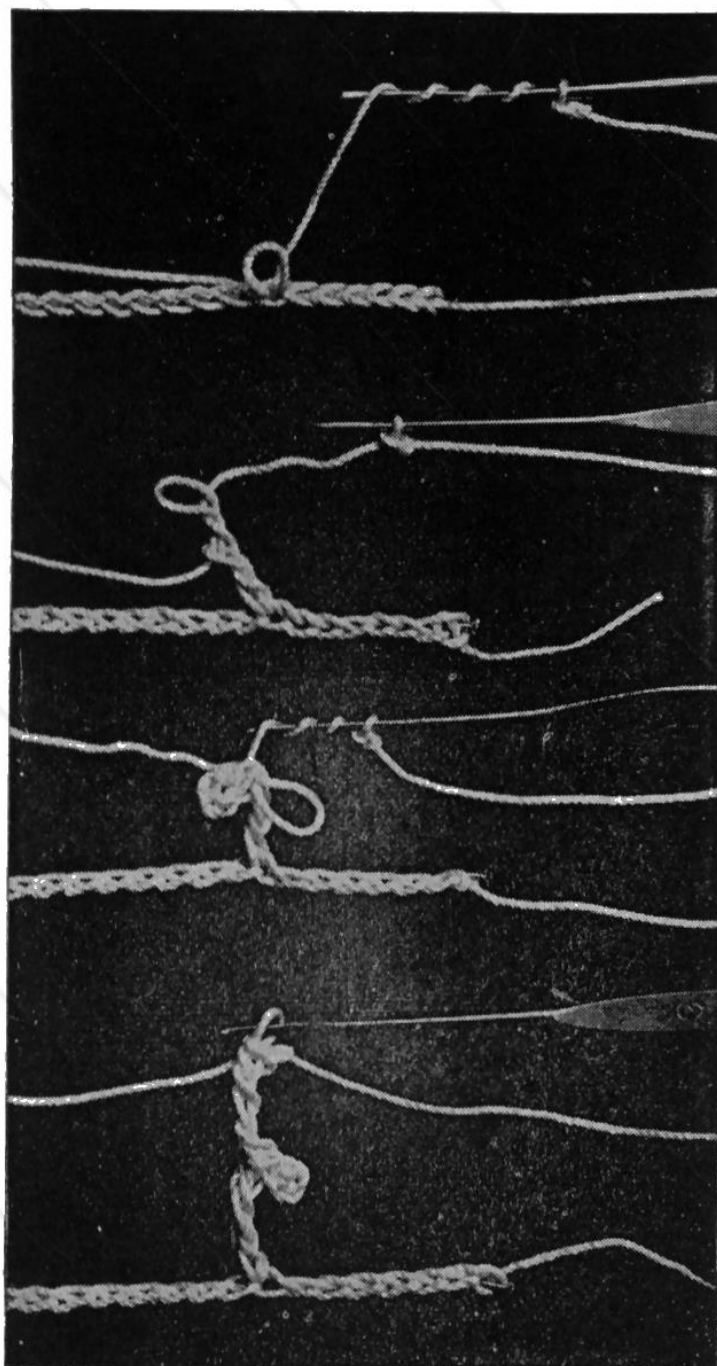
Triple treble (ttc) like treble, but thread over four times, and pull through two loops at a time for five times.

Picot (p) make a ch of three, four or five, whatever the pattern calls for. Catch back in last st from hook, thread over and pull through all.

Picot loops (pl) ch 8 p in fourth ch from hook with sl st ch 12 p—back in 4 ch from hook—ch 4.

One-half picot loop (hpl) ch 8—sl st back in 5th st from hook to form picot—ch 4 j.

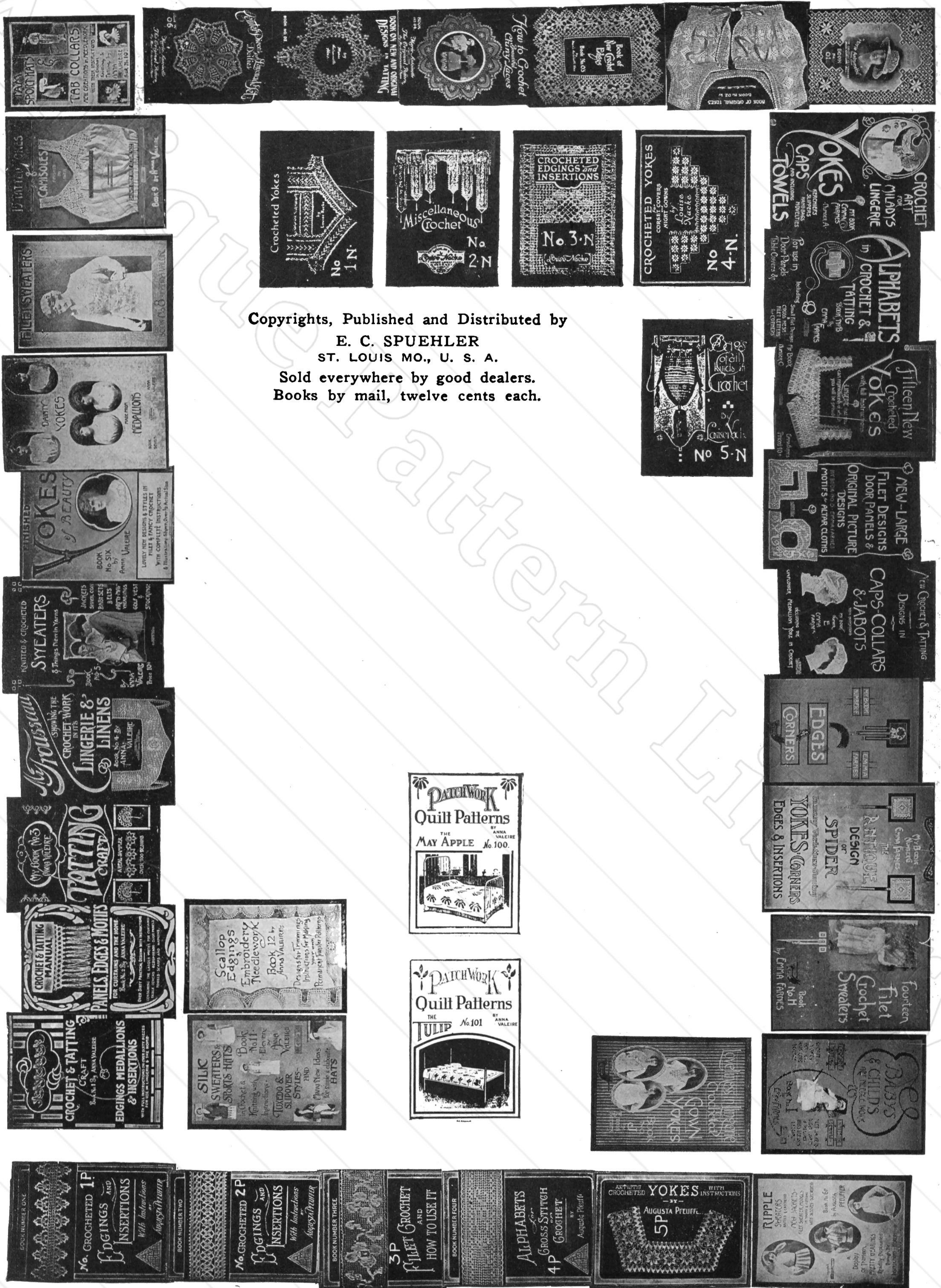

Triple Treble Crochet with Picot

We would suggest to the crocheter to get thoroughly acquainted with the Key note before starting this intricate pattern

Triple treble with picot (ttp) thread over hook four times, leave off two loops twice, still holding four loops on hook, ch four on first loop. Take hook out of first loop, still holding three loops on hook, insert hook in first ch of four, pull thread through, this will form a picot, then leave off remaining sts, two at a time.



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
