SQUARED DAISY MEDALLION YOKE.
 Siz. 36. Made in No. 60. Requires 3 Balls.
 Finished on Eight-Inch Satin Ribbon.
 Made in Slip Over Style.

Medallion; 1st Row—Ch 13, join. Ch 5, 1 pt st of 3 tr (thread over 3 times) in ring. Ch 7, pt st of 4 tr tr, 7 times in ring, ch 7 between. 2nd Row—Ch 8, 1 dc over pt st, ch 5, 1dc, ch 4, 1dc over second pt st. Ch 5, 3 dc in second st of ch just made. Ch 1, 1dc, ch 4, 1dc over pt st, rept. 3rd Row—Ch 3, 5 dc in first space, 6 dc in next and 6 dc in third space. Ch 13 over corner, 6 dc in each of next 3 spaces. At joining of medallions work 6 dc in first space, 1 sl st in corresponding st of first med. 6 dc in second space, sl st in same st of first medallion. 6 dc in third space. After fourth med is worked, join the ch sts at cor.

ners by ch 6, take up center of all 3 chs and pull thread thro all. Ch 6, joining at upper and lower edge is worked, same way, taking up 1 ch only instead of 3.

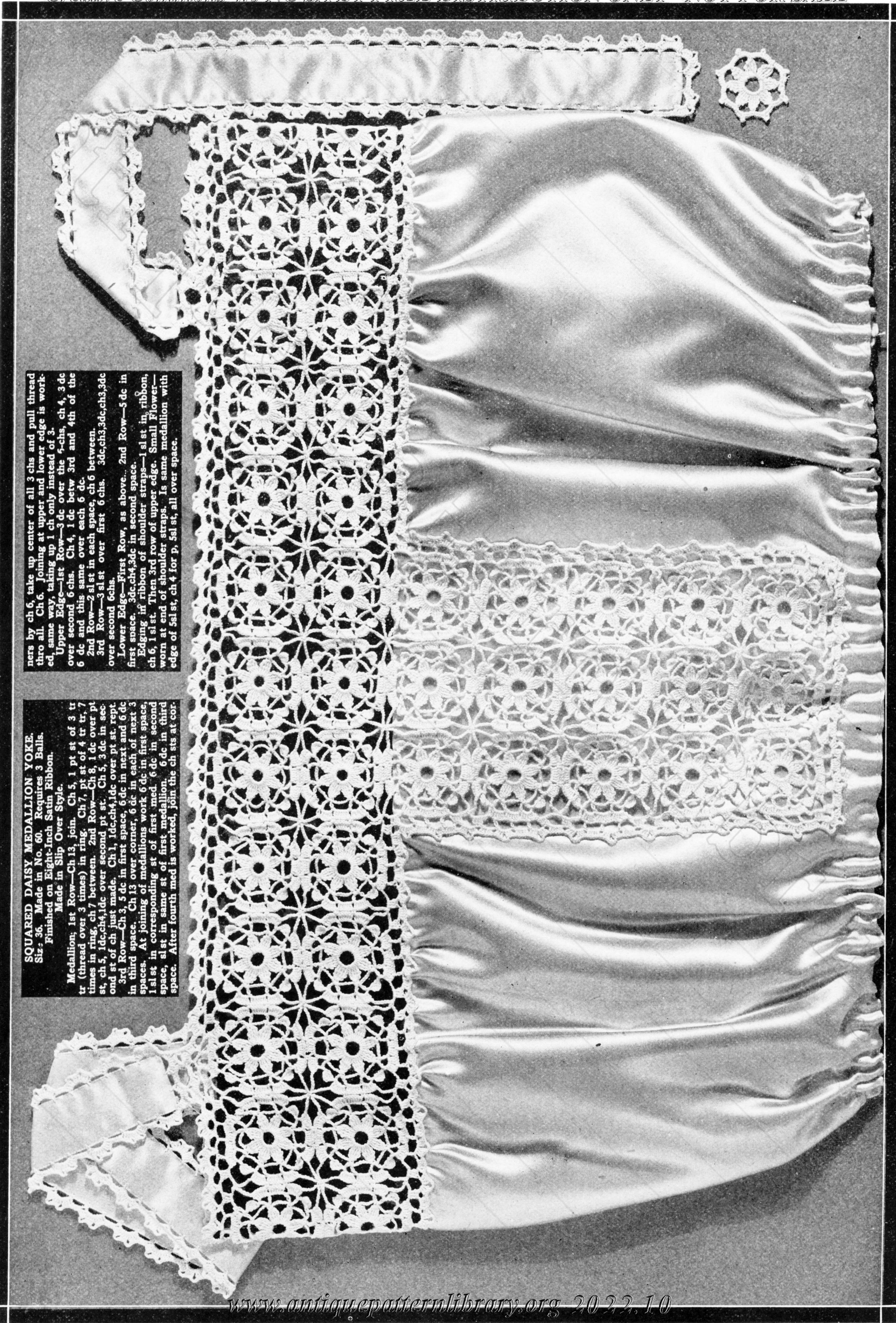
Upper Edge—1st Row—3 dc over the 5-chs, ch 4, 3 dc over second 6 chs. Ch 4, 1 dc betw 3rd and 4th of the 6 dc and this same over each 6 dc.

2nd Row—2 sl st in each space, ch 6 between.

3rd Row—3 sl st over first 6 chs. 3dc, ch 3, 3dc, ch 3, 3dc over second 6 chs.

Lower Edge—First Row, as above... 2nd Row—5 dc in first space. 3dc, ch 4, 3dc in second space.

Edging in Ribbon of shoulder straps—1 sl st in ribbon, ch 6, 1 sl st. Then 3rd row of upper edge. Small Flower—worn at end of shoulder straps. Is same medallion with edge of 5 sl st, ch 4 for P, 5 sl st, all over space.

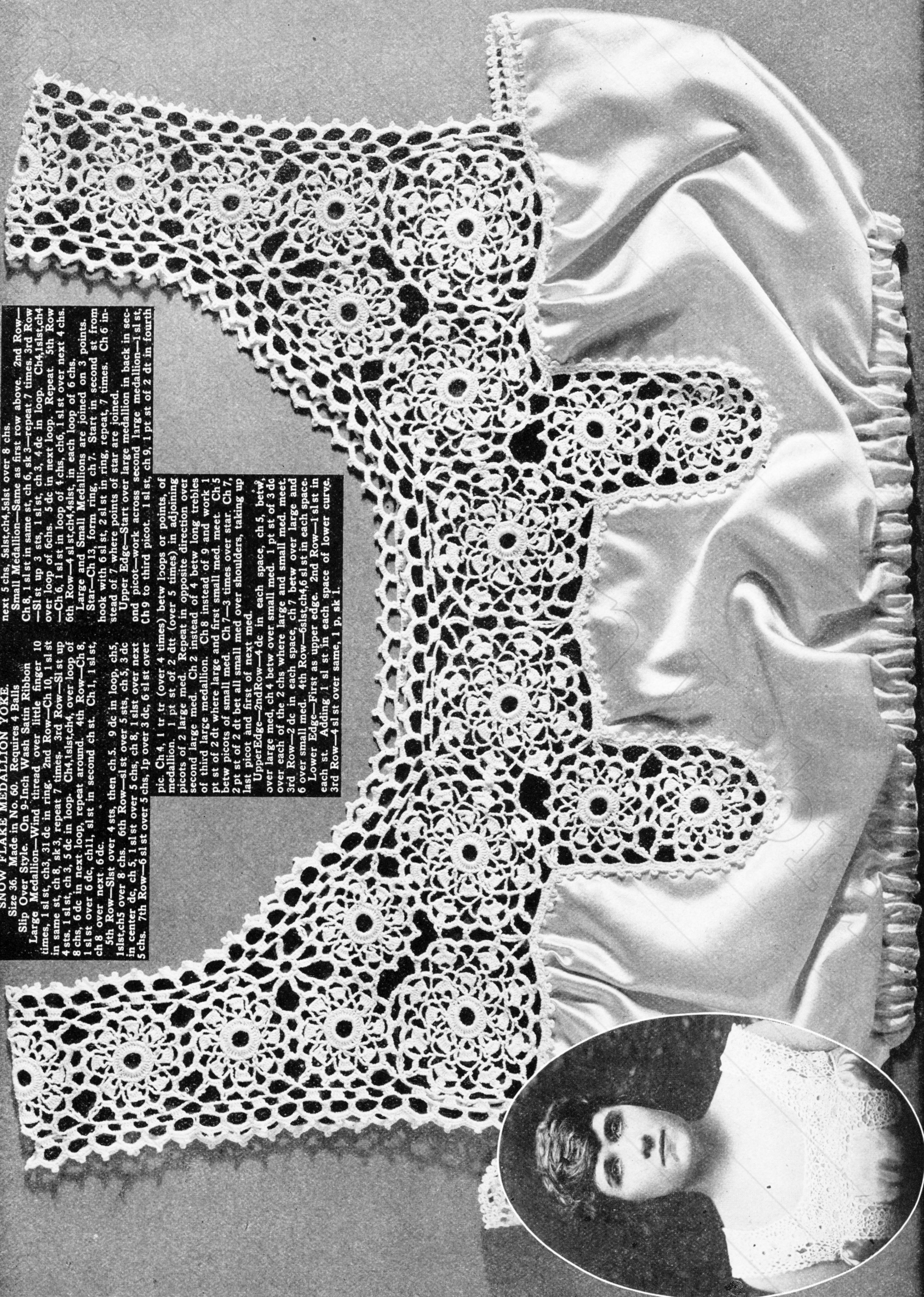


SNOW FLAKE MEDALLION YOKE.

Size 36. Made in No. 60. Requires 4 Balls Slip Over Style. On 9-Inch Wash Satin Ribbon Large Medallion—Wind thread over little finger 10 times, 1 sl st, ch 3, 31 dc in ring. 2nd Row—Ch 10, 1 sl st in same st, ch 8, sk 3, repeat 7 times. 3rd Row—Sl st up 4 sts, 1 sl st, ch 3, 5 dc in loop. Ch 4, 1 sl st, ch 4, over loop of 8 chs, 6 dc in next loop, repeat around. 4th Row—Ch 8, 1 sl st over 6 dc, ch 11, sl st in second ch st. Ch 1, 1 sl st, ch 8 over next 6 dc.
5th Row—Sl st over 4 sts, then ch 5, 9 dc in loop, ch 5, 1 sl st, ch 5 over 8 chs. 6th Row—sl st over 5 sts, ch 5, 3 dc in center dc, ch 5, 1 sl st over 5 chs, ch 8, 1 sl st over next 5 chs. 7th Row—6 sl st over 5 chs, 1 p over 3 dc, 6 sl st over

pic. Ch 4, 1 tr (over 4 times) betw loops or points, of medallion. 1 pt st of 2 dtt (over 5 times) in adjoining points of 2 large med. Repeat in opposite direction over second large med. Ch 2 instead of 4 betw long trebles of third large medallion. Ch 8 instead of 9 and work 1 pt st of 2 dt where large and first small med meet. Ch 5 betw picots of small med. Ch 7—3 times over star. Ch 7, 2 pt st of 2 dt bet all small med over shoulders, taking up last picot and first of next med.
Upper Edge—2nd Row—4 dc in each space, ch 5, betw over large med, ch 4 betw over small med. 1 pt st of 3 do over each of the 2 chs where large and small med meet. 3rd Row—2 dc in each space, ch 7 betw over large and 6 over small med. 4th Row—6 sl st, ch 4, 6 sl st in each space.
Lower Edge—First as upper edge. 2nd Row—1 sl st in each st. Adding 1 sl st in each space of lower curve. 3rd Row—4 sl st over same, 1 p, sk 1.

next 5 chs, 5 sl st, ch 4, 5 sl st over 8 chs.
Small Medallion—Same as first row above. 2nd Row—Ch 8, 1 sl st in same st, ch 6, sk 3—repeat 7 times. 3rd Row—Sl st up 3 sts, 1 sl st, ch 3, 4 dc in loop. Ch 4, 1 sl st, ch 4 over loop of 6 chs. 5 dc in next loop. Repeat. 5th Row—Ch 6, 1 sl st in loop of 4 chs, ch 6, 1 sl st over next 4 chs. 6th Row—4 sl st, ch 4, 4 sl st, in each loop of 6 chs. Large and Small Medallions are joined on 3 points.
Star—Ch 13, form ring, ch 7. Start in second st from hook with 6 sl st, 2 sl st in ring, repeat 7 times. Ch 6 instead of 7 where points of star are joined.
Upper Edge—Start over large medallion in back in second and picot—work across second large medallion—1 sl st, Ch 9 to third picot. 1 sl st, ch 9, 1 pt st of 2 dt in fourth



ROUND KNOT STITCH MEDALLION YOKE.

Size 36. Made in No. 50, Requires 4 Balls.

It is finished on 8-inch Sat.n Ribbon.

This yoke has been so much admired that I would advise those who crochet for profit to submit duplicates to any Lingerie Department for a ready sale. Ch 13, form ring. 5 sl st, ch 2, 5 sl st over half of this ring. Ch 10, turn-fasten with 1 sl st over the 2 chs, 5 sl st over last 3 chs made, repeat, and then 6 chs, join in first chain waiting, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row—9 sl st over each of four spaces. Ch 3, sk 2, a petal of 2 dc. Ch 3, sk 2. There must be 12 spaces. 4th Row—A kn st over each space. 5th Row—Make half kn st, fasten over center of first below-(doubling), then kn sts over same.

6th Row—Same way out-then ch 8 and 2 sl st around. 7th Row—Sl st out over 3 sts. Ch 1, dc, ch 3, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc over loop. Ch 6 betw. 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, ch 3, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc over next loop.

8th Row—sl st over 3 sts. Ch 8-back in 4th-for a picot. 1 dc, lp, 1 dc, lp, 1 dc over 3 chs in center of figure below. Ch 4, 1 sl st over 6 chs. Ch 4, 1 dc, lp, 1 dc, lp, 1 dc over next 3 chs between figure.

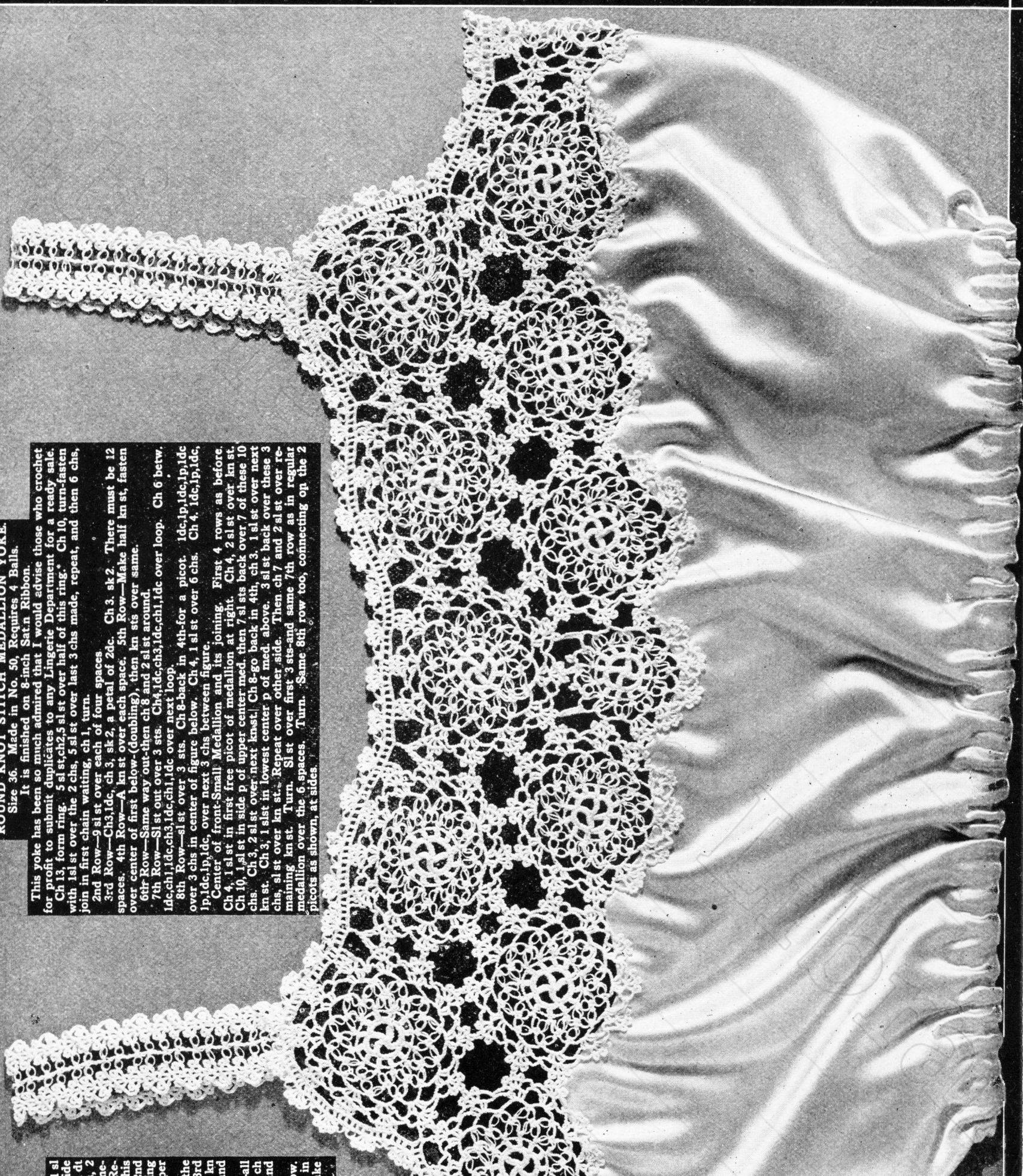
Center of front-Small Medallion and its joining. First 4 rows as before. Ch 4, 1 sl st in first free picot of medallion at right. Ch 4, 2 sl st over kn st. Ch 10, 1 sl st in side p of upper center med, then 7 sl sts back over 7 of these 10 chs. Ch 3, 2 sl st over next kn st. Ch 8-go back in 4th, ch 3, 1 sl st over next kn st. Ch 3, 1 sl st in lowest center p of med. above. 3 sl st back over these 3 chs, sl st over kn st. Repeat over other side. Then ch 7 and 2 sl st over remaining kn st. Turn. Sl st over first 3 sts and same 7th row as in regular medallion over the 6 spaces. Turn. Same 8th row too, connecting on the 2 picots as shown, at sides.

Edging—Start underarm. Over center figure 1 sl st, ch 1 in each of 3 picots, ch 8. Now for 3 side picots—1 sl st in first p, ch 1, 1 dc in second, ch 1, 1 dt in third p. Ch 5. Now with thread over 4 times, 2 dt in first lower side pic. 2 dt in same of next medallion. Work off last 2 threads on hook. Ch 5. Repeat in opposite direction. At turn under arm this connection is 1 dc to p of each medallion and 2nd row is sk 6 sts instead of 1. Over medallion holding shoulder straps—ch 9 instead of 8 over the 2 upper spaces.

2nd Row—1 dc, ch 1, skip 1. Don't skip, over the 3 sets of picots, where shoulder straps join. 3rd Row—1 dc, p, 1 dc, p, 1 dc, p, 1 dc in first space. Half kn st, sk 2 spaces. 1 sl st, half kn st, skip 2 spaces and same picot figure.

Shoulder Straps—Ch 20. 1 dc, p, 1 dc, p, 1 dc—all in 7th st from hook. Half kn st, sk 6. 1 dc in next ch st half kn st sk 6. Complete same picot figure and ch 6, turn.

2nd Row—Same picot figure in center picot below. Half kn st—now a dt instead of dc—this alternates in rows—dc and dt. Same picot figure and ch 6. Make straps to desired length, about 11 inches.



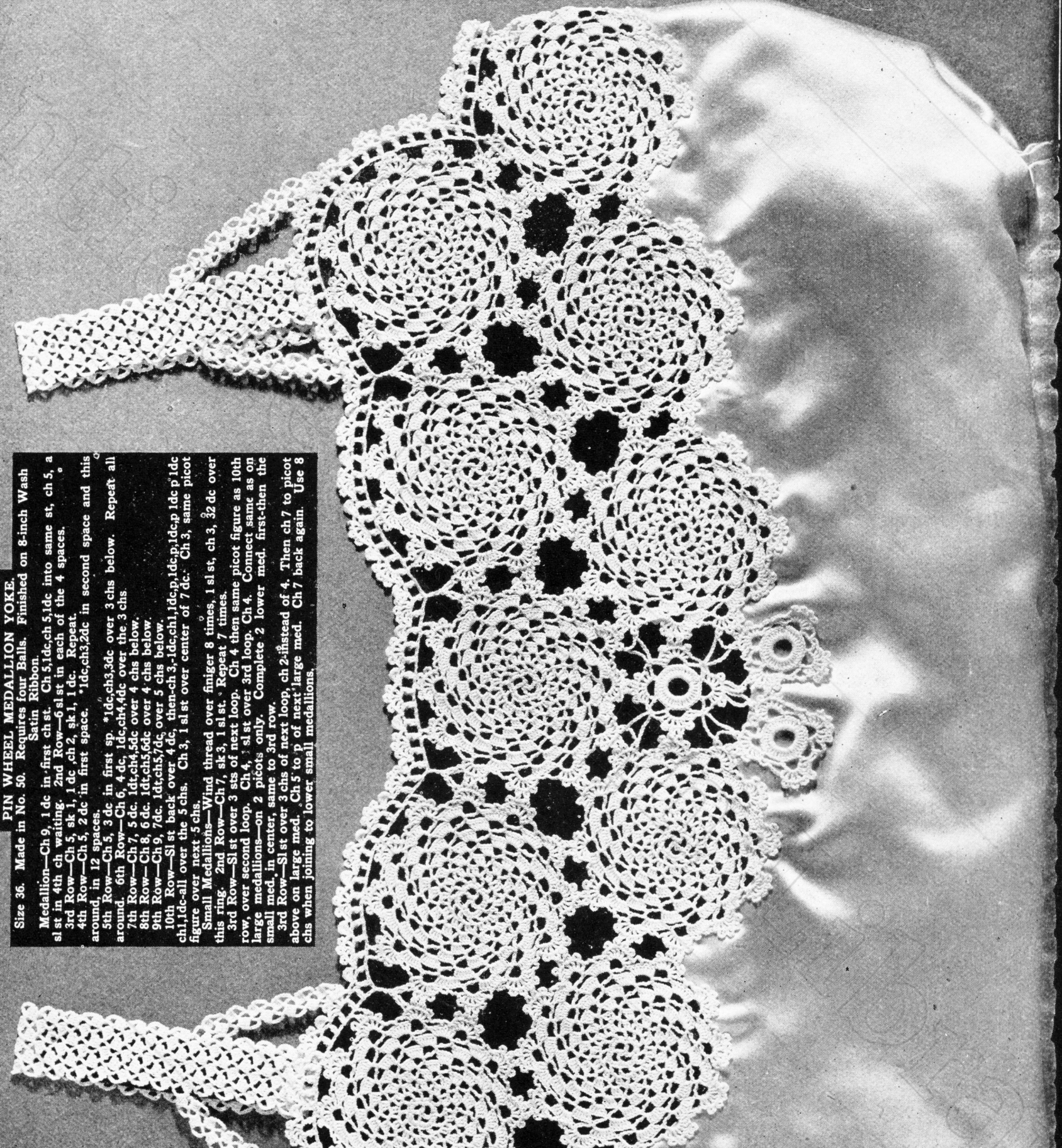
Edging—1 sl st, ch 1, sl st in 2 center top picots, on medallion under arm. Ch 8, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dt in 2 center p on side picot figure. Ch 6. Thread over hook 4 times—2 dt in nearest picot down side and 2 dt in same of next med. Work off all threads on hook. Ch 6, 1 dt and 1 dc in next figure. Ch 8, sl st, ch 1, sl st. Then join to upper med. Ch 8, a dc to both medallions, ch 8. Note—Ch-9 over 3 spaces of center of medallions holding shoulder straps. 2nd Row—1 petal st of 2 dc in first ch st. Ch 3, sk 3, 1 pet st, sk 2 instead of 3 over each medallion holding straps. 3rd Row—1 sl st in first space. Ch 4, 3 dc in first one of these 4 ch sts, 1 sl st in second space, ch 1, 4 dc with p betw each in 3rd space. Ch 4, 3 dc in first ch st.

Shoulder Straps—Ch 27, 4 dc start in 8th st from hook. Sk 3, 1 dc, ch 3, 4 dc, sk 3, 1 dc, ch 3, 4 dc. Ch 5, turn. 2nd Row—1 dc, ch 3, 4 dc over each loop of 3 chs, ch 5, turn. Repeat for about 11 inch length. Small straps to yoke start in 6th loop up on shoulder strap (each side)—1 sl st, ch 5, 4 dc. Ch 5, turn, 1 dc, ch 3, 4 dc in space of 5 chs. Ch 5, turn, 1 dc, ch 3, 4 dc over space of 3 chs.

Size 36. Made in No. 50. Requires four Balls. Finished on 8-inch Wash Satin Ribbon.

Medallion—Ch 9, 1 dc in first ch st. Ch 5, 1 dc, ch 5, 1 dc into same st, ch 5, a sl st in 4th ch waiting. 2nd Row—6 sl st in each of the 4 spaces. 3rd Row—Ch 5, sk 1, 1 dc, ch 2, sk 1, 1 dc. Repeat. 4th Row—Ch 5, 2 dc in first space. *1 dc, ch 3, 2 dc in second space and this around in 12 spaces. 5th Row—Ch 5, 3 dc in first sp. *1 dc, ch 3, 3 dc over 3 chs below. Repeat all around. 6th Row—Ch 6, 4 dc, 1 dc, ch 4, 1 dc over the 3 chs. 7th Row—Ch 7, 5 dc. 1 dt, ch 4, 5 dc over 4 chs below. 8th Row—Ch 8, 6 dc. 1 dt, ch 5, 6 dc over 4 chs below. 9th Row—Ch 9, 7 dc. 1 dt, ch 5, 7 dc over 5 chs below. 10th Row—Sl st back over 4 dc, then ch 3, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, p, 1 dc, p, 1 dc, p, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc—all over the 5 chs. Ch 3, 1 sl st over center of 7 dc. Ch 3, same picot figure over next 5 chs.

Small Medallions—Wind thread over finger 8 times, 1 sl st, ch 3, 32 dc over this ring. 2nd Row—Ch 7, sk 3, 1 sl st. Repeat 7 times. 3rd Row—Sl st over 3 sts of next loop. Ch 4 then same picot figure as 10th row, over second loop. Ch 4, sl st over 3rd loop. Ch 4. Connect same as on large medallions—on 2 picots only. Complete 2 lower med. first—then the small med. in center, same to 3rd row. 3rd Row—Sl st over 3 chs of next loop, ch 2, instead of 4. Then ch 7 to picot above on large med. Ch 5 to p of next large med. Ch 7 back again. Use 8 chs when joining to lower small medallions.



LEAF AND CROSS MEDALLIONS IN YOKE.

Size 36. Made in No. 40. Requires 4 Balls.
 Slip-over style—Made on 8-inch satin ribbon.
 Leaf Medallion—Ch 10, 1 sl st, 1 sc, 7 dc, start in second st from hook. Ch 10, repeat same sts, continue for four petals, join.
 2nd Row—Slip st up on first petal till point is reached. Ch 8, 1 dt in 4th dc of same petal, counting from center. 1 dt in 4th dc of second petal, ch 8, 1 sl st in point of second petal. Ch 8. Repeat all around.
 3rd Row—Ch 1, 11 sl sts in each of the 8 spaces, ch 1 over each petal at corners.
 4th Row—Ch 4, 1 dt, 1 p, 1 petal st of 2 dt over the 1 ch st. *Ch 3, sk 2, 1 dc, ch 2 sk 2, 1 dc, 1 p, ch 1, sk 2, 1 dc. Repeat from * in opposite direction, 1 petal st of 2 dt, 1 p, a pt st of 2 dt in the 1 ch st at corner. Join Medallions at center picots of corners and center p on sides.

Cross Medallion—Ch 11 1 dc in first ch st. Ch 6, 1 dt, ch 6, 1 dt—all in first ch st. Ch 6, 1 sl st in 5th ch st.
 2nd Row—8 sl st in each one of the 4 spaces.
 3rd Row—Sl st over first 4 sts, then ch 1, 8 sl st over 3 sts. Ch 1. Turn, 8 sl st over same just made, ch 1. Turn. 8 sl st over same. Continue till there are 5 of these rows, now sl st down on side of square and repeat 3 times. 4th Row—Ch 9, 8 sl st over same. Ch 9-repeat.
 5th Row—1 p in first sl st, ch 3, sk 2, 1 dc, 1 p, 1 dc in next 2 sts. Ch 3, sk 2, 1 p in last sl st, 5 sl st over 4 chs, ch 2, 1 dc, 3 p, 1 dc, ch 2, 5 sl st over last 4 chs. Repeat all around.

Shoulder Straps—Ch 12 start in second st from hook with 1 sl st, 1 single cr, 5 dc. Then ch 12 and repeat same sts, leaving 4 sts betw petals. Continue for desired length.
 2nd Row—Ch 8 instead of 12, start in second st from hook, making same petals. Then 1 dt in first of the remaining 4 sts betw petals. Ch 2, 1 dt in 4th st. Ch 8 for new petal.
 Edging—Start over first petal with 1 sl st, ch 5, 4 dc in second st of this ch. Ch 1, 1 sl st in second petal. The narrow edging slanting from shoulder straps are worked in same way, ch 5, 4 dc in second stitch.

Upper Edging—Start over cross medallion—1 sl st in each upper picot, ch 5, between, then over leaf medallion—ch 5, 1 dc in first space, ch 4, 1 sl st in each of next 3 picots, ch 5 betw, then ch 4, 1 dc in last space. Ch 5, 1, sl st in next picot.
 2nd Row—3 dc in 3 sts, ch 3, sk 3.
 3rd Row—1 sl st in first space. Ch 4, 3 dc in first st of this chain—1 dc, 1 p, 1 dc in second space. Ch 4, 3 dc in first st of this ch. 1 sl st in 3rd space. Ch 5, 4 dc in second st of this ch, 1 dt, p, 1 dt in 4th space. Ch 5, 4 dc in second st of this ch, 1 sl st in 5th space.
 Lower Edging—1st row-like upper. Ch 3, instead of 5 over the 4 inner corners, ch 6 in-
 2nd Row—4 sl st over 4 sts, 1 p, sk 1.

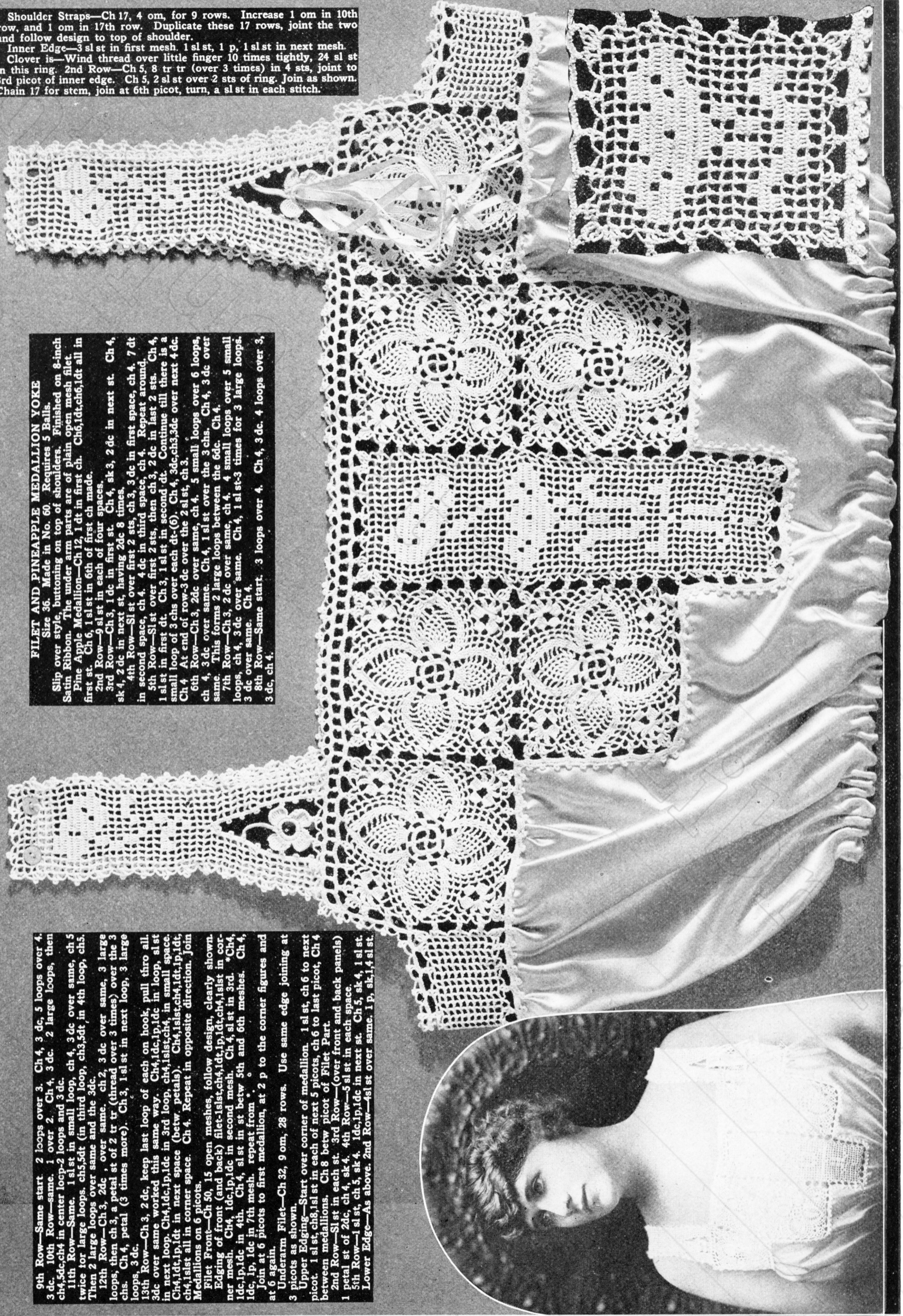


Shoulder Straps—Ch 17, 4 om, for 9 rows. Increase 1 om in 10th row, and 1 om in 17th row. Duplicate these 17 rows, joint the two and follow design to top of shoulder.
 Inner Edge—3 sl st in first mesh, 1 sl st, 1 p, 1 sl st in next mesh.
 Clover is—Wind thread over little finger 10 times tightly, 24 sl st in this ring. 2nd Row—Ch 5, 8 tr tr (over 3 times) in 4 sts, joint to 3rd picot of inner edge. Ch 5, 2 sl st over 2 sts of ring. Join as shown. Chain 17 for stem, join at 6th picot, turn, a sl st in each stitch.

FILET AND PINEAPPLE MEDALLION YOKE

Size 36. Made in No. 60. Requires 5 Balls.
 Slip over style, buttoning on top of shoulders. Finished on 8-inch Satin Ribbon. The under arm parts are of plain open mesh filet.
 Pine Apple Medallion—Ch 12, 1 dt in first ch. Ch 6, 1 dt, ch 6, 1 dt all in first st. Ch 6, 1 sl st in 6th of first ch made.
 2nd Row—9 sl st in each of four spaces.
 3rd Row—Ch 3, 1 dc in first st. Ch 4, sk 3, 2 dc in next st. Ch 4, sk 4, 2 dc in next st, having 2dc 8 times.
 4th Row—Sl st over first 2 sts, ch 3, 3 dc in first space, ch 4, 7 dt in second space, ch 4, 4 dc in third space, ch 4. Repeat around.
 5th Row—Sl st over first 2 sts, then ch 3, 2 dc in last 2 sts. Ch 4, 1 sl st in first dt. Ch 3, 1 sl st in second dt. Continue till there is a small loop of 3 chs over each dt-(6). Ch 4, 3dc, ch 3, 3dc over next 4 dc.
 Ch 4 At end of row-3 dc over the 2 sl st, ch 3.
 6th Row—Ch 3, 2dc over same, ch 4, 5 small loops over 6 loops, ch 4, 3 dc over same. Ch 4, 1 sl st over the 3 chs. Ch 4, 3 dc over same. This forms 2 large loops between the 6dc. Ch 4.
 7th Row—Ch 3, 2 dc over same, ch 4, 4 small loops over 5 small loops, ch 4, 3 dc over same. Ch 4, 1 sl st-3 times for 3 large loops, 3 dc over same. Ch 4.
 8th Row—Same start. 3 loops over 4. Ch 4, 3 dc. 4 loops over 3, 3 dc, ch 4.

9th Row—Same start. 2 loops over 3. Ch 4, 3 dc, 5 loops over 4, 3 dc. 10th Row—same. 1 over 2. Ch 4, 3 dc. 2 large loops, then ch 4, 5dc, ch 4 in center loop-2 loops and 3 dc.
 11th Row—Same. 1 sl st in small loop, ch 4, 3 dc over same, ch 5 twice for large loops. ch 5, 5 dt (in third loop, ch 3, 5 dt, in 4th loop, ch 5. Then 2 large loops over same and the 3dc.
 12th Row—Ch 3, 2dc, over same. ch 2, 3 dc over same, 3 large loops, then ch 3, a petal st of 2 tr tr (thread over 3 times) over the 3 chs. Ch 4, petal (3 times more). Ch 3, 1 sl st in next loop, 3 large loops, 3 dc.
 13th Row—Ch 3, 2 dc, keep last loop of each on hook, pull thro all 3dc over same worked this same way. Ch 4, 1dc, 1p, 1dc in loop, sl st in next loop. Ch 4, 1dc, 1p, 1dc in 3rd loop, ch 4, 1sl st, ch 4, in small space. Ch 4, 1dt, 1p, 1dt in next space (betw. petals). Ch 4, 1sl st, ch 4, 1dt, 1p, 1dt, ch 4, 1sl st all in corner space. Ch 4. Repeat in opposite direction. Join Medallions on 6 picots.
 Filet Front—Ch 50, 15 open meshes, follow design, clearly shown. Edging of front (and back) filet-1sl st, ch 4, 1dt, 1p, 1dt, ch 4, 1sl st in corner mesh. Ch 4, 1dc, 1p, 1dc in second mesh. Ch 4, sl st in 3rd. *Ch 4, 1dc, 1p, 1dc in 4th. Ch 4, sl st in st betw 5th and 6th meshes. Ch 4, 1dc, 1p, 1dc in 7th mesh, repeat from.
 Join at 6 picots to first medallion, at 2 p to the corner figures and at 6 again.
 Underarm Filet—Ch 32, 9 om, 28 rows. Use same edge joining at 3 picots as shown.
 Upper Edging—Start over corner of medallion. 1 sl st, ch 6 to next picot. 1 sl st, ch 8, 1 sl st in each of next 5 picots, ch 6 to last picot, Ch 4 between medallions. Ch 8 betw picot of Filet Part.
 2nd Row—Sl st in each st. 3rd Row—(over front and back panels) 1 petal st of 2dc, ch 4, sk 4. 4th Row—5 sl st in each space.
 5th Row—1 sl st, ch 5, sk 4. 1dc, 1p, 1dc in next st. Ch 5, sk 4, 1 sl st. Lower Edge—As above. 2nd Row—sl st over same. 1 p, sk 1, 4 sl st.

Special instructions—Beginning at star just above lower panel. After 2 sl sts in last loop of wheel—Ch 6, pt st of 2 dt to point and loop. Ch 5 to point, ch 5 to pt again, ch 5, pt st of 2 dt betw stars. Ch 3 to pt, ch 3, pt st of 2 dt betw stars. Ch 5 to pt, ch 5 to pt again, ch 5, pt st of 2 dt to pt and loop of wheel. Ch 6, 2 sl st in loop, ch 6, pt st of 2 dt in picot of wheel and pt of star. Ch 6 to pt—7 to pt—7 to pt—7 to pt. Ch 5—now—long trebles pt st of 2 dt (thread over 4 times) into loop, 1 tr tr in picot, and pt st of 2 dt in next loop. Repeat as over the last star to first small wheel under arm. Ch 1, sl st in first p, ch 5 to p of next med, ch 4 to picots. Ch 5 betw meds all the way to back panel. On the inner side of these 9 small wheels there are 3 chs betw picots and 4 betw medallions. Where the first of these meets the front at arm hole—at turn, ch 4, pt st of 2 dt, ch 3, pt st of 2 dt, ch 3, pt st of 2 dt, ch 3, pt st of 2 dt, then ch 7 as usual.

Lower and upper stars in front work out on 5 and 6 chs betw points as above mentioned.
 I believe everything else can be seen readily and judged from the general instructions.

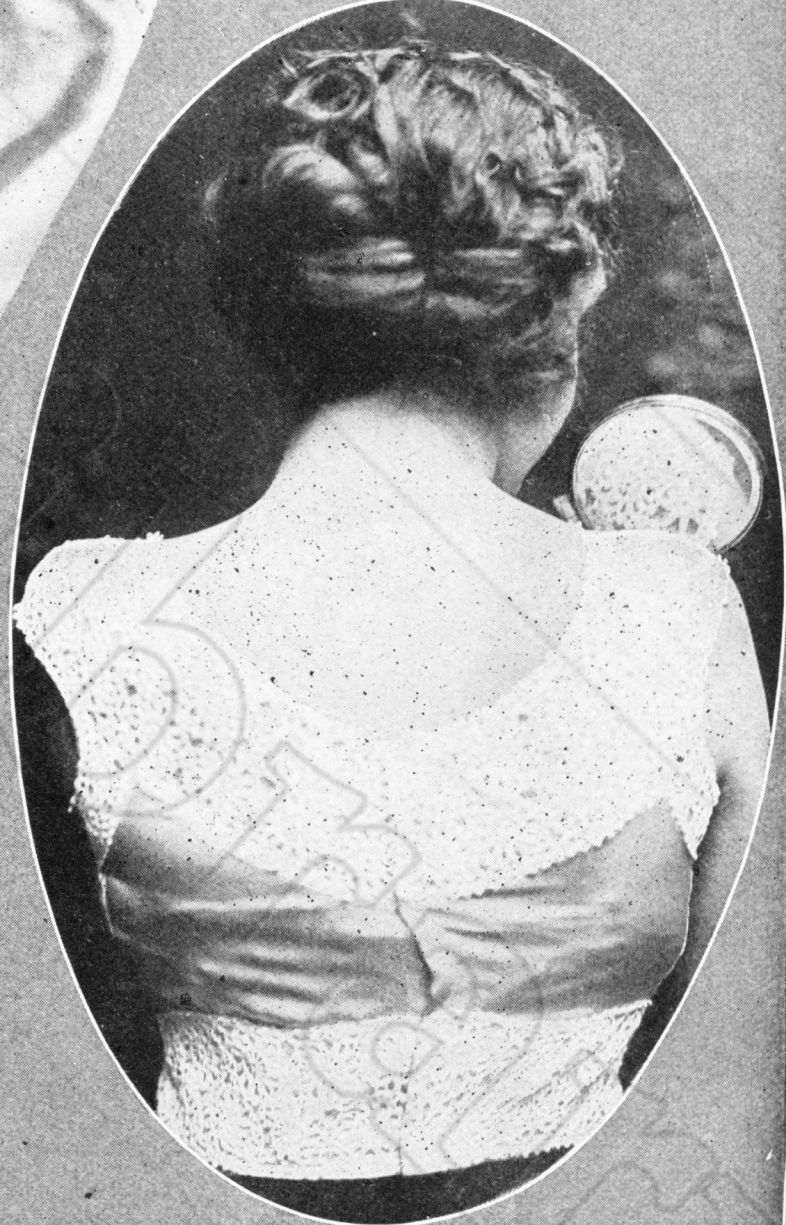
Lower Edge—2nd Row—4 sl st over same, 1 p, sk 1. Do not skip this 1 st over curves, or turns in edge.

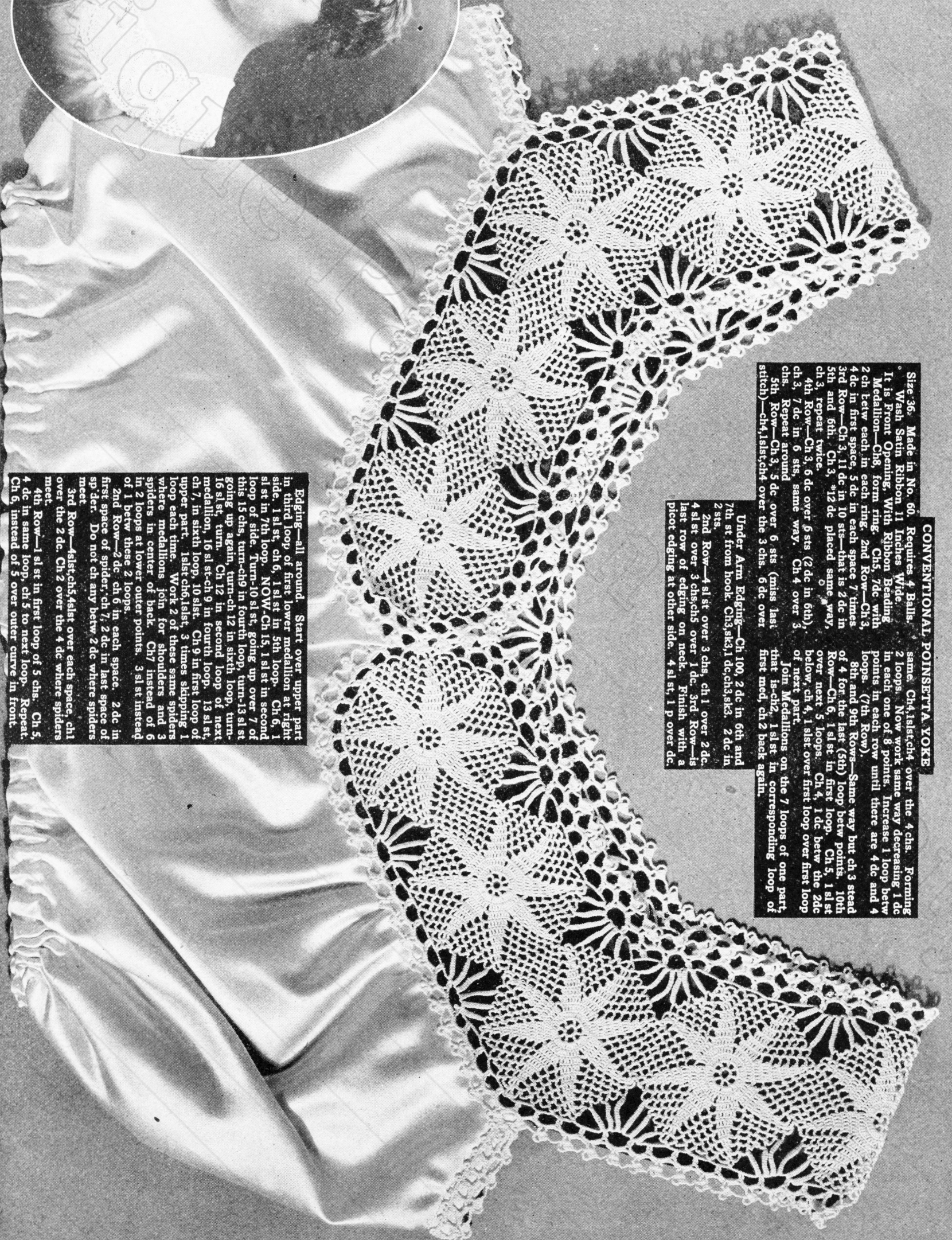
The joining of the star at top of shoulder is shown in the mirrored picture. Joins by 2 points to each of 3 med in corresponding loops. Two of the points—forward and back—are made longer, 9 chs instead of 7 and 2 more dc.

A VARIED MEDALLION BRASSIERE
 Or an Elegant Dress Trimming if Worked in Silk.
 Requires Satin Eleven Inches Wide.
 Size 36. Made in No. 50. Requires Five Balls.
 It is open in back and uses Snap Fasteners.
 Complete 11 wheel medallions first, being one side of the upper front panel, joined as shown, on 2 loops, wherever touching. Note the setting of 12th medallion—next to star on top of shoulder. Leave this and the star till later. Complete 13 medallions for back panel, then insert the star and top medallion—(called 12th). Make the 2 bottom panels of 16 med each. Complete and join as shown the 2 large medallions. Then insert the star medallions. Under each arm are 9 small wheel medallions, being the first 2 rows of the regular wheel. Complete these as shown.
 See the instructions on each of above medallions and on edges.

Edging—1st Row—Start at back. 2 sl st in first upper loop of wheel medallion, ch 6, 2 sl st again. Ch 8, a pt st of 2 dt in side loop of medallion, and again in side loop of next medallion. Ch 8. In arm hole ch 7 instead of 8. 2nd Row—Upper—1 sl st in each st. 3rd Row—A petal st of 2 dc in 1 st, ch 3, sk 3. 4th Row—1 sl st over petal st, ch 5. 1 sl st over next pet st, ch 5—start in second st from hook; 1 sl st, 1 sc, 2 dc—1 sl st in 3rd pt st.

Large Center Medallion—Ch 9, form ring. Ch 7, 11 dt with 3 chs betw each in ring. 2nd Row—3 sl st, ch 1 in each space.
 3rd Row—Ch 3, 1 dc, ch 4, 1 pet st of 2 dc over each ch st, ch 4, betw. 4th Row—6 sl st in each space. Ch 1 over each pet st.
 5th Row—Ch 12, start in second st from hook with 1 sl st, 1 sc, 4 dc, 5 dt, 1 sl st over the one ch st. Ch 12, repeat. 6th Row—Sl st up over first one of these 12 petals. Ch 5, 1 dtt (thread over 4 times) in the one slst below. Ch 5, 1 sl st in point of next petal. Ch 5, repeat. 7th Row—3 sl st, ch 5, 3 sl st over each 5 chs.
 8th Row—Sl st over next 6 sts, ch 3, 2 dc in picot of 5 chs. Ch 5, 3 dc in next picot, ch 5 between. 9th Row—Sl st over next 5 sts, 1 picot over loop of 5 chs. Ch 8 to next loop, 1 p in loop. Ch 8. Join the two large medallions on 4 loops, that is 1 dc in first loop, a sl st in each of next two and 1 dc in last.
 Small Star Medallion—First Row—Ch 9, form ring. Ch 3, 1 dc. * Ch 2, 2 dc, 7 times. 2nd Row—Ch 7 start in second st from hook with: 1 sl st, 1 sc, 4 dc, 1 sl st betw the 2 dc (if a joining is made, ch 6, instead of 7—1 sl st in point of star or in loop of medallion, then work same sts back again).
 Wheel Medallion—Ch 9, form ring, ch 7, 11 dt with 3 chs betw each in ring. 2nd Row—2 sl st, ch 5 for picot, 2 sl st in each of 12 spaces.
 3rd Row—Sl st over next 4 sts. Ch 3, 2 dc in picot. Ch 5, 3 dc in next picot, ch 5. 4th Row—Sl st over next 4 sts, 1 picot in loop of 5 chs, ch 7 to next loop, 1 picot in loop, ch 7. Join medallions by placing third medallion above first and second, connecting 2 loops to each medallion. Small medallions under arm are these first 2 rows.





CONVENTIONAL POINSETTA YOKE

Size 36. Made in No. 60. Requires 4 Balls. Wash Satin Ribbon 11 Inches Wide. It is Front Opening. With Ribbon Beading Medallion—Ch 8, form ring. Ch 5, 7dc with 2 ch betw each in each ring. 2nd Row—Ch 3, 4dc in first space, 5dc in each space 7 times 3rd Row—Ch 3, 11dc in 10 st—that is 2dc in 5th and 6th. Ch 3, *12dc placed same way, ch 3, repeat twice. 4th Row—Ch 3, 6dc over 6 sts (2dc in 6th), ch 3, 7dc in 6 sts, same way. Ch 4 over 3 chs. Repeat around 5th Row—Ch 3, 5dc over 6 sts (miss last stitch)—ch 4, 1st ch, ch 4 over the 3 chs. 6dc over same. Ch 4, 1st ch, ch 4 over the 4 chs. Forming 2 loops. Now work same way decreasing 1dc in each one of 8 points. Increase 1 loop betw points in each row until there are 4dc and 4 loops. (7th Row) 8th and 9th Rows—Same way but ch 3 stead of 4 for the last (3th) loop betw points. 10th Row—Ch 6, 1st st in first loop. Ch 5, 1st st over next 5 loops. Ch 4, 1dc betw the 2dc below, ch 4, 1st over first loop over first loop of next part. Join Medallions on the 7 loops of one part that is—ch 2, 1st st in corresponding loop of first med, ch 2 back again.

Under Arm Edging—Ch 100, 2dc in 6th and 7th st from hook. Ch 3, sk 3, 1dc, ch 3, sk 3. 2dc in 2 sts. 2nd Row—4sl st over 3 chs, ch 1 over 2dc. 4sl st over 3 chs, ch 5 over 1dc. 3rd Row—is last row of edging on neck. Finish with a picot edging at other side. 4sl st, 1p over dc.

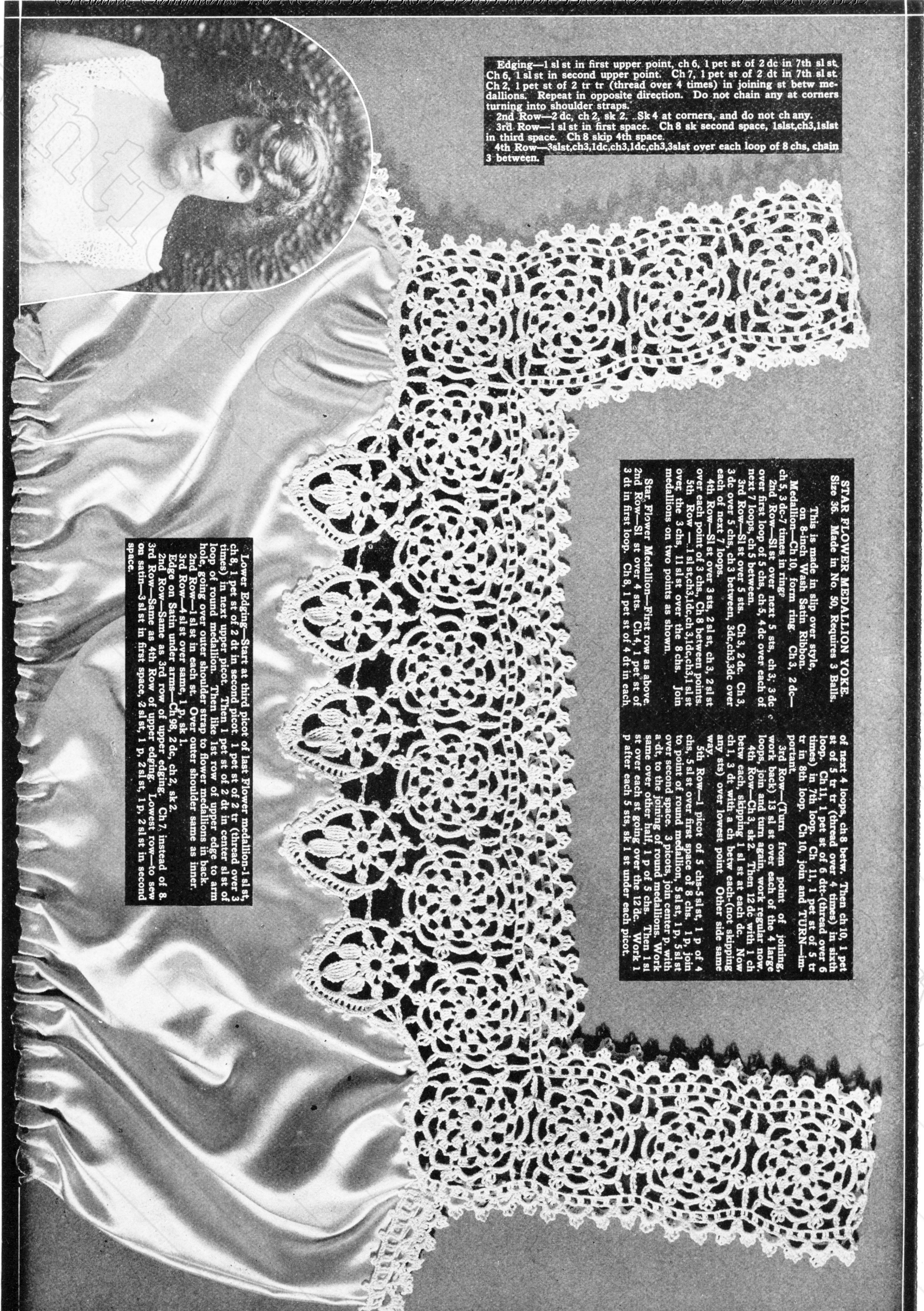

Ch 5, 4dc in same loop, ch 5 to next loop. Repeat. Ch 6, instead of 5 over outer curve in front.

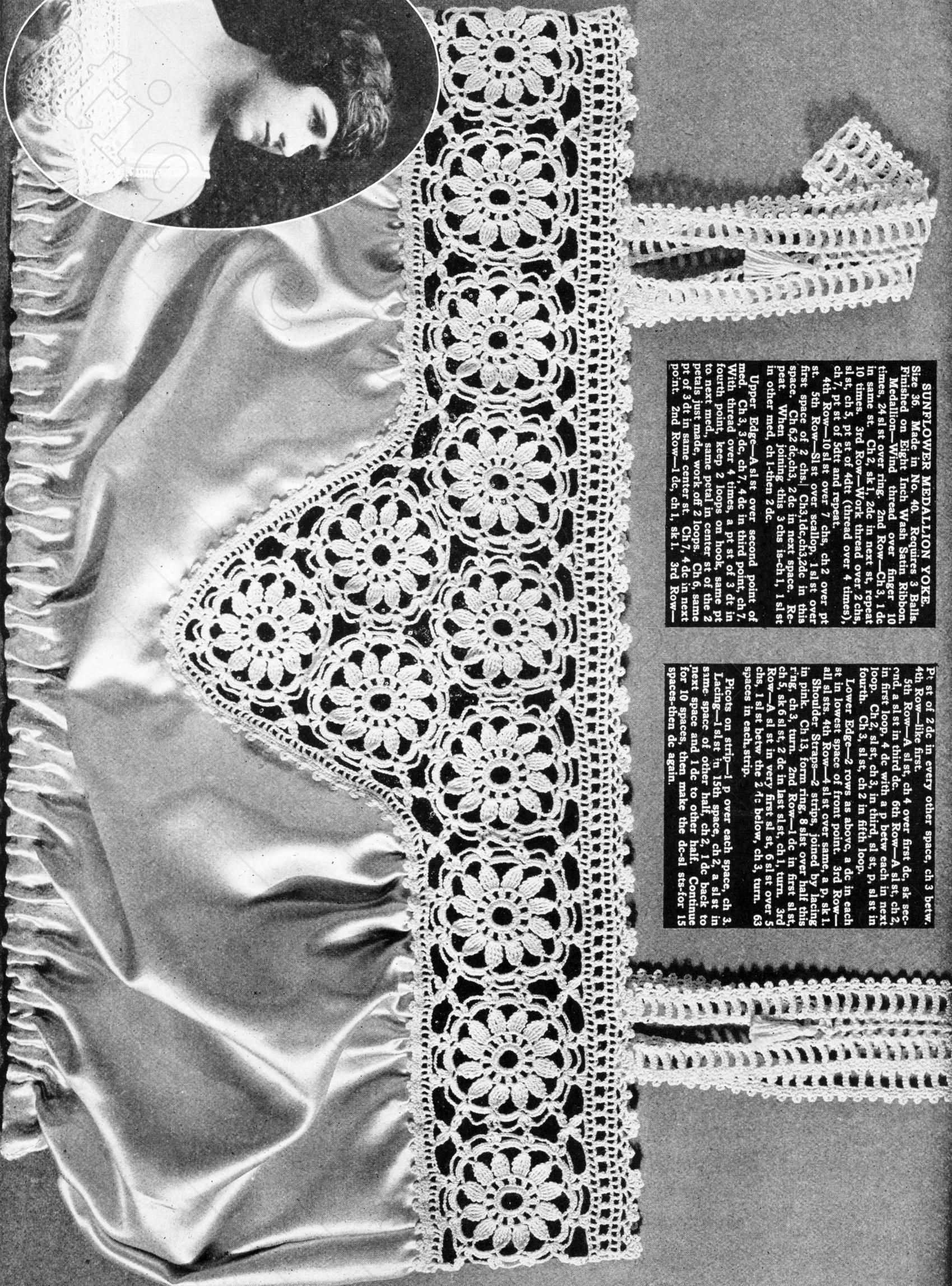
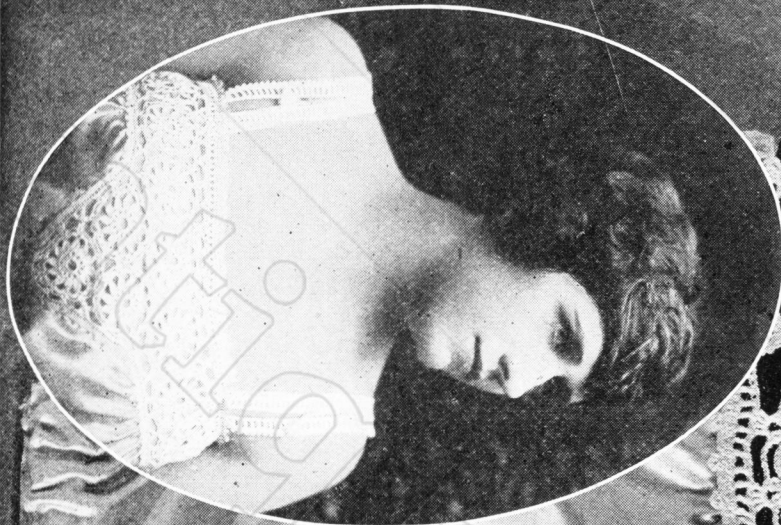

Fasten, sl st tightly up to head. Ch 3, 2 sl st
in center of head. Ch 3, sl st tightly down
on other side until corresponding st is
reached, to work other wing.
Honey Suckers—Ch 4, 3 dc in first ch, ch
9, 2 sl st under head, ch 13-3 dc in 4th st from
hook. A few sewing stitches back and
forth on wrong side will allow you to puff
body.



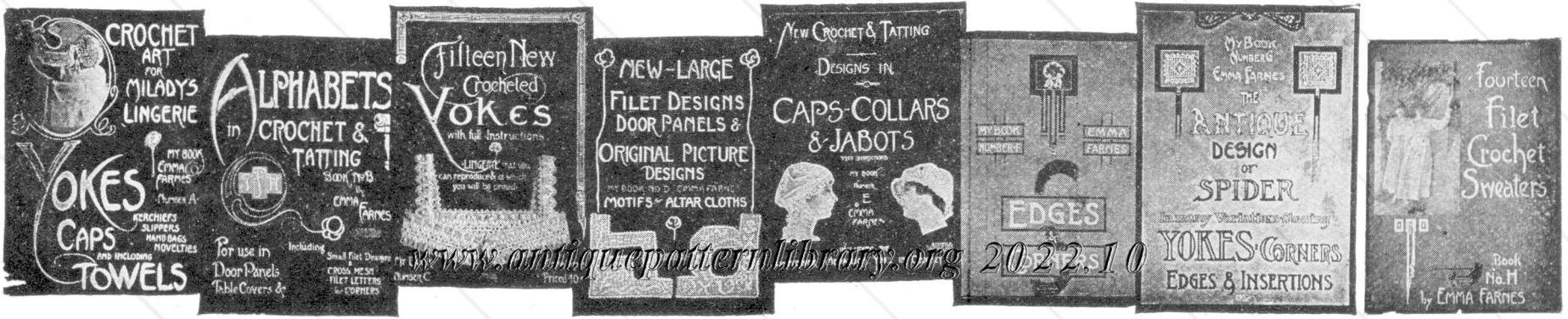
Knct Stitch Medallion. No. 40.
 Thread over finger 10 times. Ch 3, 39 dc in ring.
 2nd Row—*Ch 10, sl st in same st, 1 kn st, sk 4,
 sl st in next st. Repeat 7 times. 3rd Row—
 Sl st over 3 sts, ch 3, 5 dc in loop. Ch 1, kn st,
 ch 1, 6 dc in next loop. 4th Row—Kn st over
 6 dc, pl-cing the sl st in the 1 ch st, ch 13, 1 sl st
 in third ch st, ch 2. 1 sl st in 1 ch st.
 5th Row—Half kn st over same, then other
 half out to start new row, ch 1-9 dc in loop, ch
 1, 1 kn st over safe. 6th Row—Half kn st over
 same. 1 sl st, ch 5, 3 dc in center dc, ch 5, 1 sl st
 in 1 ch st, ch 8 over kn st. 7th Row—6 sl st
 over 5 chs, 1 p over 3 dc, 6 sl st over next 5 chs.
 5 sl st, ch 5, 5 sl st over 8 chs.
